Option 3: Honors Study Abroad Programs organized through the Honors

College Off-campus programs in Spain, Italy, Peru or China.

Option 4: Research projects through the Student Research and Artistic

Initiatives Program. (Work submitted must be approved the SRAI

Director.)

Most fourth year students will pursue Option 1, a continuation of the interdisciplinary studies you have been following up to this point. If you choose any other option, it is your responsibility to make arrangements with both your Honors College faculty member and with your department faculty member. The Honors College staff is available to advise you about the options and to explain the program to individuals in your major department. Remember, however, that involvement by faculty members or departments in Options 2 and 4 is entirely at their discretion.
