

## **Guidelines for Rotary Scholarship**

Scholarship award priority will be given to applicants who have not been awarded other scholarships or educational financial grants.

## Applicant must:

- 1. Be a citizen of the United States
- 2. Be a resident of the State of Michigan.
- 3. Be a High School senior who intends to further his or her education at a two or four year college, university or state certified trade or technical school. (A provisional acceptance letter, if available from such institution should be submitted with this application.)
- 4. Be of good character, be well motivated, and have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.4.
- 5. Participated in extracurricular activities at Owosso High School.
- 6. Provide up to two letters of recommendation from the following character evaluation resources or other people:
  - School representative
  - Clergy (as applicable)
  - Community Volunteer Representative
- 7. Provide a typed or computer printed essay (500 words) reflecting on the Rotary 4-way test as explained on this application.
- 8. Provide this completed application.

All scholarship applications must be submitted to Mrs. Pilon in the SSC by 3:00 p.m., Fri., May 6, 2016.
