ADULT/JUNIOR TOURNAMENT

SCRATCH AND HANDICAP DIVISIONS

Eligibility: Junior bowler must be a certified Westchester County USBC Association Member.

Adults must be certified members of USBC.

ENTRY FEE:

\$70.00 PER TEAM PREPAID.

\$75.00 PER TEAM FOR WALK ONS. (SPACE PERMITTING)

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. FORMAT: Handicap Division: Teams will bowl 5 games across 10 lanes in the qualifying round. 85% of the difference in the teams average and 400 will be added to each game. 40% of the field will advance to the semi-final round and will bowl 3 Baker Style match games.* All totals will be carried forward from the qualifying round, and a 30 pin bonus will be added for each match play victory. The top 5 bowlers at the end of the 8 games will then bowl in the stepladder finals. 85% of the difference in the teams averages will be the handicap in the finals.

 Scratch Division: Entrants will bowl 5 games across 10 lanes in the qualifying round. 40% of the field will advance to the semi-final round and will bowl an additional 3 Baker Style match games.* All totals will be carried forward from the qualifying round, and a 30 pin bonus will be added for each match play victory. The top 5 teams at the end of the 8 games will then bowl in the stepladder finals.
- 2. This tournament will begin with the qualifying round at 11:00 A.M. All teams should be ready to check in 45 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time. Those entrants not ready to check in 45 minutes prior to scheduled starting time may lose their reserved spot in the tournament.
- 3. The entry fee for this special tournament shall be \$70.00 pre-paid. Entry fee breakdown: \$50.00 bowling fees, \$10.00 trophy expense, and \$10.00 tournament expenses. (Trophy expense returned 100%) NO ENTRY FEE CAN BE RETURNED. (Walk-on Fees will be added to the prize fund).
- 4. Trophies will be awarded to all finalists in each division. Trophies will also be awarded for the highest scratch game and the highest scratch 5 game series (in the qualifying round) for both the adult and child as individuals from both the scratch and handicap divisions.
- 5. The tournament is limited in the number of entries that can be accommodated. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. NO telephone reservations can be accepted. Teams whose entries are received after the tournament has been filled will be notified. Walk-in entries will be accepted if space permits.
- 6. All rules not specifically covered will be governed by the rules of the USBC. The tournament director reserves all rights.
- 7. For adult participants: USBC rule 319E will apply to all participants; USBC Rule 319D will not apply; USBC Rule 319A will apply.
- 8. ADULT ENTERING AVERAGE RULES: Adults entering shall use their current certified league average (minimum of 21 games) as of entering date, or last year's final book average, which ever is higher. If adult has neither of the above qualifications the adult may enter at scratch (200).
- 9. Special Format Rules: Adult must bowl first in the qualifying. In the *semi-final rounds and in the step-ladder finals the adult will bowl the 1,2,5,7, & 9th frames; the junior will bowl the 2,4,6,8, & 10th frames. (Handicap division only: handicap will be half of the 85% of the difference of the teams' averages.)

2012-13 JUNIOR BOWLING TOUR ENTERING AVERAGE RULE:

- 1. Juniors must enter at their highest average in any junior league or their final WCJBT (minimum 15 games) from the 2011-12 season.
- 2. Or his/her highest average in their current league (minimum 15 games).
- 3. Or the bowler's Westchester County Juniors Bowling Tour current average based on 15 games for the 2012-13 season (WHICH EVER IS HIGHER - Please note re-rating rules).

2012-13 JUNIOR BOWLING TOUR AVERAGE RE-RATING RULES:

Bowlers who have bowled less than 15 games in the 2012-13 WCJBT season will be re-rated according to the following procedure:

- A) Bowlers with less than 5 games in WCJBT competition will not be re-rated.
- B) Bowlers with 5 games, but less than 15 games in WCJBT competition will take the average of his/her entering average, which will be used if it is higher than the bowler's entering average.

EXAMPLE:	Entering Average	140
	Current WCJBT Average	160
	Total	300
	Bowler's re-rated average (300 divided by 2)	150

C) Bowlers with 15 games or more in WCJBT competition will use his/her current WCJBT average or his/her average, whichever is higher.

NOTE: The Junior Bowlers Tour Average Re-Rating Rule is designed to keep all bowlers as competitive as possible.

All bowlers are continuously re-rated that may deemed necessary by the tournament director.
