Proving Triangle Theorems - Step-by-Step Lesson

Prove: Triangle Sum Theorem

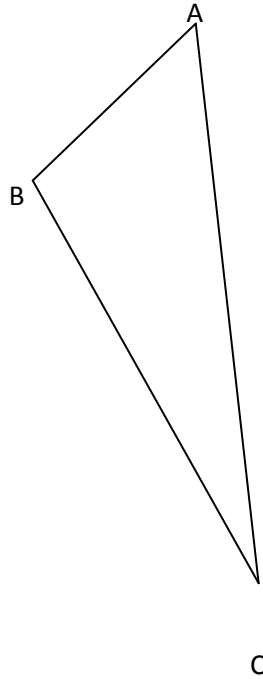
Given :

$$\angle A = 52^\circ$$

$$\angle B = 105^\circ$$

Prove:

$$\angle C = 23^\circ$$



Explanation:

The sum of the measures of the angles of a triangle is 180° .

$$\angle A + \angle B + \angle C = 180^\circ$$

$$42^\circ + 105^\circ + \angle C = 180^\circ$$

$$\angle C = 180^\circ - 157^\circ$$

$$\angle C = 23^\circ$$
