4. Contents and results gained



Mode of study:	Full time modularized study (four semesters in two years including practical placement, examinations, and Master thesis)
Programme requirements/ qualification profile of the graduate:	Special scientific study about 4 semester to convey a basic knowledge as well as the methods and theories per studying course as soon as 100 credit points and 20 credit points for the master exam. (totally 120 Credit points accorded to the ECTS) There is an average workload of 1.800 hours per semester. It will be converted into 60 credit points (30 credit points per semester). One credit point relates a workload about 30 hours.
Details	Aim of qualification It is the aim of this master-course in „counseling“ to intensify practical competencies and theoretical knowledge which had been acquired in former BA- or diploma-courses with regard to the theory and practice of counseling in different fields and to improve and enlarge them in an interdisciplinary way. The examination will find out and ascertain if the candidates (i) are able to reflect adequately on „counseling“ as a basic form of communication from different disciplinary perspectives, and (ii) have acquired the necessary practical competencies in order to be able to work as a leading practioner in specific practical fields of counseling grounded on scientific knowledge and methods according to the typical profile of this university of applied sciences.
Optional domain:	Multidisciplinary studies to acquire job market or interdisciplinary qualifications in line with the M.A. study – divided in following domains: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. foreign languages,2. Presentation, communication and argumentation,3. Information technology,4. Interdisciplinary studying objects and/or supplemental studying objects of other courses,5. practical training Overall at the end of the successful conclusion you have to prove minimum 30 CP, shared to minimum three of the five domains. The grade of a module of the optional domain agrees as an exam relevant grade to the M.A.-grade.
