Camp of the Rising Son's Camper Scholarship Guidelines

At Camp of the Rising Son we believe that every child should have the opportunity to experience the life-changing love of Christ through a week of camp. Our camper scholarship fund has been created for the purpose of providing assistance to help children attend camp who otherwise would not be able to do so. These funds are made possible through generous donations received from supporters who believe in the power of a week of camp to impact a child's life.

Who is eligible?

All potential campers in financial need are eligible to apply. First consideration for scholarships is given to a camper who have not previously attended CRS or received a scholarship to CRS. Past scholarship recipients are then considered. Scholarships are only available for one week of camp per camper.

Does a scholarship cover all costs?

No. Scholarships are given based on individual need and the parent or guardian must pay any remaining balance.

Does applying for a scholarship mean my child is registered for camp?

No. To reserve a camper spot in any week, we must have received a registration form and deposit (\$100/camp or \$200/trips)—this can be done online or by mailing in a paper form. If you choose to wait to see if a scholarship is awarded to your child before paying the deposit there will *not* be a spot held in a particular week for your child. Once a scholarship is awarded, you must accept and pay the deposit within two weeks to officially register your child in a week of camp.

Will I be guaranteed a scholarship?

Unfortunately, we are unable to grant every scholarship request. Each year we receive more requests for scholarships than we are able to fulfill. For this reason, we ask that all families contribute towards their child's week at camp to the extent available.

What do I do if my camper is awarded a scholarship?

The scholarship offer will be good for 2 weeks. Once learning of your scholarship offer, you need to contact the camp office by phone or email to let us know you have accepted the scholarship. If we do not receive your acceptance in that time, we will use the funds to offer a scholarship to another camper. Once you accept the scholarship you must pay the remaining balance due by May $1^{\rm st}$.

Will there be any differences for my child while at camp?

No! At CRS all campers have the same camp store options and activity options. No limitations are placed on our scholarship campers.

When are scholarship applications due?

Scholarships will be awarded on a monthly basis beginning in February on a first-come, first-serve basis with priority to first time campers, so apply early! All remaining scholarship funds will be awarded immediately after the April 1st deadline.
