SHOOTING CAMP

JUNE 25-26 | AGES 8-18

Each camper will receive a North Carolina blue and white Lady Tar Heel basketball and a camp tee shirt. Each camper will be taught fundamental systematic approach to shooting, a step-by-step shooting progression, shooting drills and shot selection – everything you need to improve your shot. This camp has been highly praised for its success in improving player's shooting percentages.

POSITION CAMP

JUNE 25-26 | AGES 8-18

Special feature: Each camper will receive a NC Blue & White Tar Heel Basketball and a camp tee shirt. Players will receive individual instruction on their Skill Development. Post Players will work on playing with their back to the basket, posting and scoring in the paint, being a good offensive rebounder, rebounding defensively, block-outs, starting the fast break outlet pass, using screens, use of the bank short and many other aspects of inside play. Guards or perimeter players will work on how to get open, footwork triple-threat position, one-on-one moves, ball handling and passing skills, reading screens and shooting the three-point shot.

INDIVIDUAL CAMP

JUNE 26-29 | JULY 3-6 | AGES 8-18

In addition to the coaches of the Tar Heels, the camp staff will consist of members of the University of North Carolina women's basketball team, former collegiate players, pro players, and current college, high school, and junior high school coaches. The camper-to-counselor coach ratio will be approximately 6 to 1. Each camper will receive individual attention as well as small group instruction in order to improve her basketball skills. Without a doubt, the best camp staff in America.

Special Feature: Each camper will receive a North Carolina blue and white Lady Tar Heel basketball, a camp tee shirt, and an individual picture with Coach Hatchell. This camp will be divided into 6 or more age and ability groups for instruction and competition. Emphasis will be placed on fundamentals, individual defense, individual offense, and shooting techniques. Each camper will have the learning opportunity to improve her skills and develop an increased enjoyment for the game of basketball. Awards will be given in each age group for Hot Shot Champion, Free Throw Champion, and One-on-One Champion. Each team will play at least nine games against teams of similar ability. Teams will be divided into leagues by coaches choice or by competition level. Awards will be given in each league for best defensive team, best offensive team, best rebounding team, best shooting team and sportsmanship award. Games will be officiated by certified officials.

Seminars will be held on study skills, time

management, conditioning, strength training, leadership,

team building and nutrition. Clinics will be held throughout Team Camp for players and coaches in facilities like Woollen and Fetzer gymnasiums. One coach attends at no charge (minimum of 8 players) and will be responsible for supervising their team. Teams will play in the Dean E. Smith Center and Carmichael Auditorium (where Michael Jordan played). What better way to get your team ready for the upcoming season! he Tar Heels have produced twelve professional players, four All-Americans, four Atlantic Coast Conference rookies of the year, and back-to-back 30-win seasons.

In fact, with a 30-5 record in 1995, Hatchell became the first UNC basketball coach, men's or women's, to post back-to-back 30-win seasons. And in 1994. Hatchell was named the National Coach of the Year by USA Today and College Sports Magazine.

Sylvia Hatchell is in her 19th year as Carolina's coach and her 30th year as a head coach. She has led the team to an average of 21.2 wins per year over the past 18 seasons and to 24 wins per year over the past six.

Hatchell led Francis Marion to the NAIA national championship in 1986 and to an AIAW title in 1982. Although the Tar Heels success has been building since Hatchell took over the reins, it was the landmark 1994 season that saw the Tar Heels go 14-2 in the ACC regular season and win Hatchell's first ACC title plus Carolina's first NCAA national title. The Tar Heels set a school record for wins with 33, and their 33-2 overall record was the best in college basketball. Carolina finished the season ranked fourth in the AP poll and first by USA Today. Prior to taking over the Tar Heel program, Hatchell guided Francis Marion College to a 273-80 mark over 11 seasons. She coached the 1986 Lady Patriots to a remarkable 36-2 record and a National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics national championship. Her

1982 team also won a national championship in the AIAW small college division, making Hatchell the only coach known to have won national titles in NCAA, NAIA, and AIAW competition.


Actively involved in shaping modern women's basketball, Hatchell is a past

president of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association. Hatchell has previously been a member of the WBCA Board of Directors and a member of USA Basketball Women's Games Committee. A native of Gastonia, N.C., Hatchell graduated cum laude from Carson-Newman College. In March 1994, she was honored as the Carson-Newman Distinguished Alumnus-of-the-Year.

In 1975, Hatchell received her MS degree from the University of Tennessee.

Her husband, Sammy Hatchell, is currently the head boy's basketball coach at Cresset Christian Academy in Durham, N.C. The couple's son, Van, is 16 years old and in the tenth grade at Cresset Christian Academy. Sammy and Van enjoy working at the Lady TarHeels basketball camp every summer.


