<u> Travel Program - Overview</u>

The mission of the travel program is to provide a competitive playing experience for the more advanced players in the league. Each team will consist of approximately 12 players selected following a try-out process. We will have teams for age groups: 8 thru 12. Teams will play in tournaments or leagues and travel is involved. The season begins during the spring when teams practice and may run through the beginning of August. Playing on a travel team is a major commitment for the player and the family. Plan on having a game or practice every day during the season. If you have a vacation or other commitment (i.e. sleep away camp) during the travel season, your child should not plan on playing travel baseball. If a player misses a game he will only be allowed to play 2 innings per game for an equivalent number of games that were missed.

Who Is Eligible?

The travel program is open to children playing in FRB who live in Flemington Borough or Raritan Township. In order to be on a travel team, the player must play in the FRB Recreation Program during the Spring of 2013. The player will play in the proper age group based on their age as of 4/30/2013. Travel players are prohibited from playing in any other baseball program (independent teams, AAU, etc...) during the FRB spring/summer season (defined as Opening Day - August 15th).

Try-Out Process and Team Selection

The try-out will consist of a series of drills in order to evaluate skills. The evaluators will be experienced coaches. No evaluator will work with an age group in which they have a child trying out for a team. Coaches are selected by the league board of directors. Player selection is the responsibility of the travel committee.

Player Notification

A representative of the travel committee will notify each player selected to a travel team following the player selection process. The player may accept or decline the offer to be a member of the travel team. Only one team in each age group will be formed at this time. After a full team is set at each age group the travel committee will determine if there are enough qualified players to form a second team. If a second team is to be formed a similar player notification process will be used.

<u>Registration Fee</u>

The registration fee is due before the first try-out session. No player will be placed on a travel team if the registration fee has not been paid. Players that do not make a team will have their checks returned to them. Please make sure you understand the commitment level required before the try-out.

Minimum Playing Times

This is travel and as such teams strive to be as successful as possible on the field and in the development of all the travel players. While it's not a requirement to have equal playing time every player should have a fair opportunity to play and show what he or she can do.

All players will have a minimum of **2 innings in the field and 1 at bat** in tournament games. All teams must bat all players in tournaments that allow all rostered players to bat.

In the Cal Ripken tournaments (Districts, States,etc), where only 9 players are in the lineup by rule, every player must have at least **1 inning in the field or 1 at bat**. It should be noted that these are not targets, these are the mandatory minimums. Each coach should strive to get all players as much playing time as possible, targeting a minimum of 50%.
