

# 2013 Call for Nominations: AIBC Special Certificate of Recognition

The AIBC Volunteer Recognition Committee encourages and invites nominations for the AIBC Special Certificate of Recognition. This award was established by the AIBC specifically to recognize those individuals or firms who have made an **exceptional**, **sustained and significant** contribution to the practice or profession of architecture through volunteer activities.

#### Criteria

The volunteer contribution will have been exceptional, sustained and significant. Nominations must be made by an AIBC architect, other individual registrant, or architectural firm, and should detail the candidate's volunteer activities, the organizations with which these activities took place, and the timeframe in which they occurred. The volunteer activities cited may have been made at the local, provincial or national level, and should demonstrate expertise and leadership in specific initiatives that benefit or enhance the practice and profession of architecture.

#### **Eligibility & Nomination Process**

Nominations are open to any AIBC architect, other individual registrant, or architectural firm. Eligible candidates must be nominated by three AIBC architects or other individual registrants in good standing, and nomination may be made with the support of an external professional group or representative with first-hand knowledge of the nominee's contribution. Submissions should outline the nominee's contribution in sufficient detail as necessary within the criteria noted above. Each nomination is to be accompanied by a brief biographical profile, and must provide details of the nominee's qualifications as demonstrated through response to the submission requirements.

#### **Nomination Review Process**

All nominations will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy and forwarded to the AIBC Volunteer Recognition Committee for review and recommendation to AIBC Council.

The nomination package, including the **original signatures** of three supporting AIBC architects or other individual registrants, must be submitted in writing (neither e-mail nor facsimile will be accepted) along with the nominators' phone and e-mail contact information.

#### **Nomination Deadline**

Nominations must be received **before 4:30 p.m. on August 26, 2013, to the attention of the Executive Director** at the AIBC Office, #100-440 Cambie Street, Vancouver, B.C. V6B 2N5.
