NATIONAL CFAV CLAY TARGET SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2016

INTRODUCTION

1. The fourth National CFAV Clay Target Shooting Championships, a competition for units of the Combined Cadet Forces, the Sea Cadet Corps, the Army Cadet Force and the Air Training Corps will take place at the Cambridge Gun Club's Shooting Ground, Cottenham, Cambridge CB24 8AH on $23^{rd} - 24^{th}$ April 2016. Accommodation for (70) Individuals who request it will be in Cambridgeshire ACF's HQ Waterbeach, postcode CB25 9QU, see attached map. Those that do not wish to stay at Cambridgeshire ACF's centre must find their own accommodation.

THE EVENT

2. The Event will this year consist of training for Shotgun Skills qualification modules 1 & 2 and practice on the Saturday morning plus some coaching for those requiring it, followed by the competition starting at 1200 on the Saturday afternoon and Sunday.

THE COMPETITIONS

- 3. The Individual Championships will consist of the following shot under CPSA Rules:
 - a. 100 Bird Sporting;
 - b. 25 Bird Down the Line (DTL);
 - c. 25 Bird Skeet;

There will be a trophy for each discipline. In addition the leading individual with the highest aggregate of the Sporting, DTL and Skeet will receive the High Gun trophy.

4. There will be a concurrent Team Competition for teams of 3 from one unit consisting of the aggregated scores achieved in the Individual competitions.

5. There will be **practice stands** open from 1000, you will be able to enter paying cash on the day to the club, the cost will depend on what you do.

<u>ENTRY</u>

6. Units wishing to enter a team for the Championships and or Individuals for training and or the Championships are to submit their entry on the form at Annex A, by 1st March 2016 accompanied by a cheque for the appropriate fee as shown on the entry form, payable to CCRS. Late entries are unlikely to be accepted. Guest shooters may be invited by the Clay Target Shooting Committee after the closing date to shoot for honours only.

7. All competitors must provide their own cartridges, plastic or fibre.

8. If over subscribed, a refund will be made to any individual that can not be accepted but refunds will not be made to Individual's who withdraw at short notice, unless they can be replaced by another individual.

9. After the closing date, the Individuals / teams, whose entries have been accepted, will be notified and will be sent detailed instructions that will require the immediate submission of an accommodation and messing return and other details.

10. In the event of bids exceeding the number of vacancies, the Committee will allocate places, and a Reserves List will be created.

11. All competitors **must be enrolled and serving CFAV's or Civilian Instructors on unit strength** with the possible exception of invited guests. Teams may be mixed male/female. All firers must prove that they have passed the Shotgun Safety Handling Test before firing and it must be entered on Westminster/Bader.

STAFFING

12. Help with the administration of the event is vital. Details of the assistance needed are at Annex B. Please complete and return this Annex with your entry form whether you have suitable candidates for any of the rolls or not. Regrettably VA costs have to remain with units as CCRS is not funded with them for this event.

GENERAL

13. Be aware that **All Entrants staying at Waterbeach will be required to arrive by 2200 on Friday 22nd April 2016** and they must provide their own sleeping systems.

14. It is imperative that returns are submitted on time.
