Introduction

The art class serves as an opportunity for children / students to discover the pleasure of creating art at an advanced level. It allows self-expression integral to a personal development, observation enhancement and build own confidence.

Course Details

- Draw, paint, construct and collage landscape, still life and portraiture with a variety of materials.
