My apology for not getting this out earlier in the week but I have just returned from Melbourne.

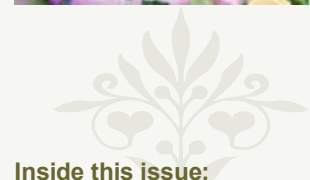
As this is the last workshop for the year let's make it a good one. Don't forget if you enjoy our morning teas then bring something.
