A Continuing Competence Program (CCP) Activity Log is a standardized template used to document learning activities linked to the completion of Learning Objectives as listed on an annual Learning Plan and is requested at the time of a CCP compliance audit. The College will accept an alternate document provided it is well-organized, chronological, an easy-to-follow format (e.g. Excel spreadsheet), and contains all of the required information captured in the CCP Activity Log.

Dedicated hours refers to the time (in hours) of instruction, participation, review, learning, etc. necessary for an individual to complete a learning activity.
