Enclosed for your convenience is a map showing the various parking locations, formation area and parade route.

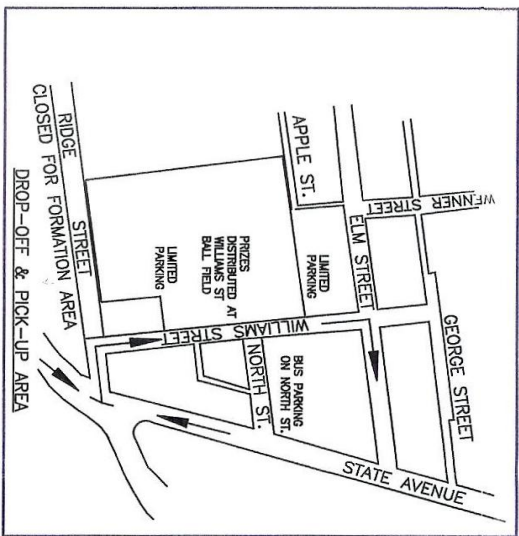
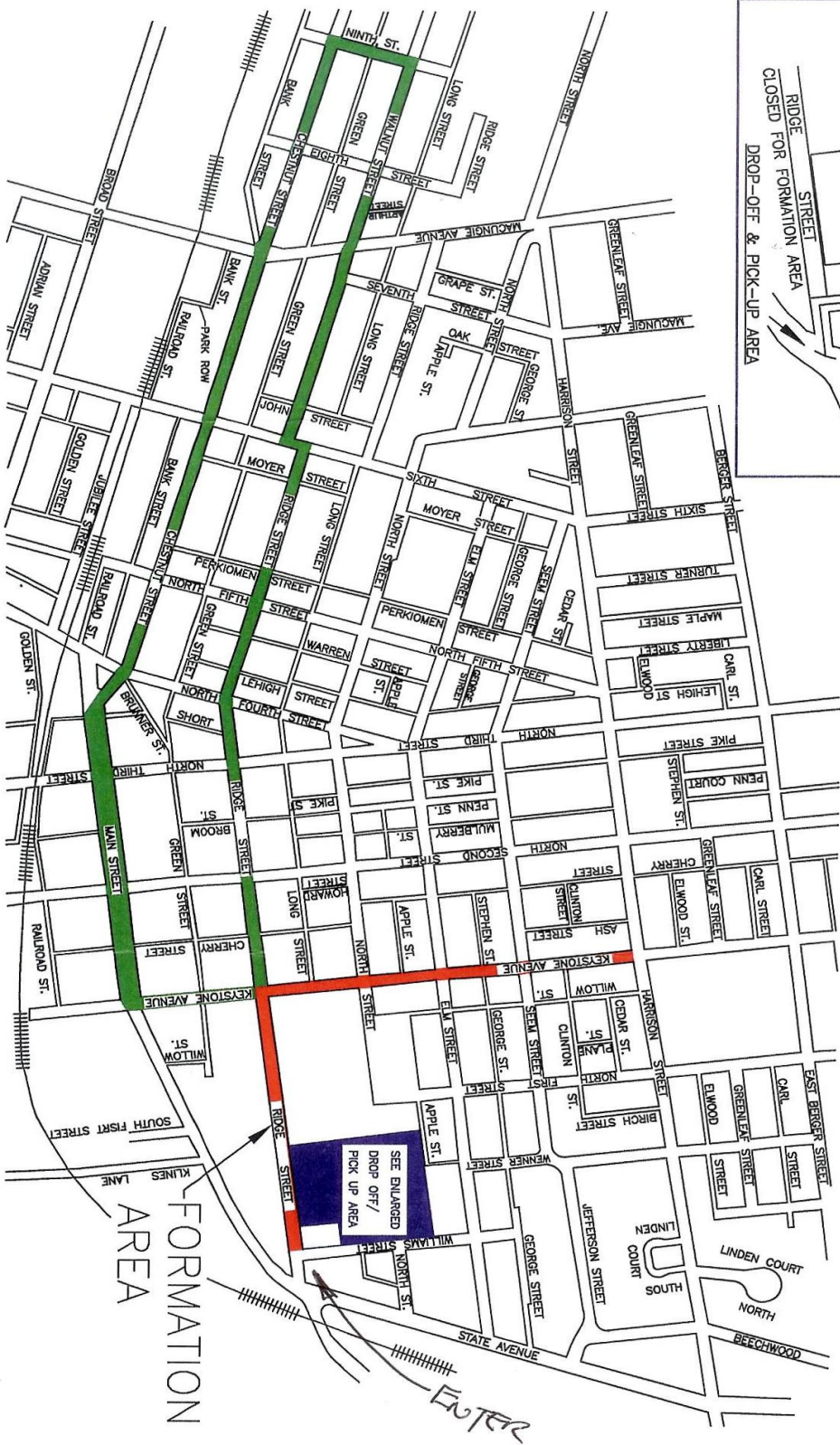
