A Note from the Office...

In two short weeks, Wyndcroft will be undergoing its ten year accreditation review with the Pennsylvania Association of Independent Schools. One major component of this review will include an overview of all school safety procedures. Parents should be aware that our car/ bus arrival and dismissal will be watched closely by the visiting committee. In order to ensure that everyone is clear on our carline policies and procedures, we felt a review was in order.

From the Parent Handbook...

CAR LINE: All parents of students in grades kindergarten through eight should use the car line for arrival and dismissal in order to help ease congestion around the school. Do not park near the school at these times unless there is a pressing need to do so. When picking your child up in car line, please remember to put the **sign with your child's name on it (provided by the school) in your window.**



Specific Reminders...

A.M. Carline

Approach the school observing all speed limit requirements. In a single file line, cars will pull up to the two unloading "stations" where staff will be waiting to assist your children. To allow for two vehicles to unload at the same time, always pull forward to the station closest to the exit. The intent is for children to leave the vehicle on the passenger side, but in a few cases multiple doors are opened simultaneously and students walk around the stopped vehicle, so please, never pull forward around a stopped vehicle.

P.M. Carline

Approach the carline parking lot from Highland/Mulberry Drive. Enter the lot joining one of the three column queues. Please have your family name sign in clear view at all times. Continue moving forward until you reach the first position where a staff member will greet you and open the door for your child(ren). Please do not get out of the vehicle. If you need to make seat belt adjustments, please exit the driveway and pull over in an open space on the Highland House side of Rosedale Drive. When all are set, carefully rejoin the traffic pattern. **Once the dismissal procedure begins, cell phone use is not permitted.**
