VEHICLE INFORMATION

Securing a Driver's License:

Individual will need:

- Two documents to identify themselves
- Legal INS documents
- Certificate of Naturalization, if they are a citizen
- Record of arrival and departure with a valid foreign passport
- Certificate of Identity
- Employment authorization card



Insuring a Vehicle:

Individuals will need:

- International drivers license or a state driver's license
- Social Security number
- Vehicle information: driver's name, make, model, VIN# (vehicle identification number)
- If vehicle has a loan, full insurance coverage will be needed.
- If vehicle is completely paid, only liability insurance is needed in South Dakota
- License plate tags need to be renewed every year when taxes are paid on vehicle at County Treasurer's Office.

BANKING

To open a bank account

- \$25 is needed to open a saving or checking account at most banks.
- Individuals will need a drivers license or other photo ID.
- Could use permanent resident card or the International Driver's License.
- Social Security number, permanent ID, or INS documents are required.
- Credit checks are done.



Wal-Mart & Hy-Vee charge about \$10 to wire money out of the country. There is no fee to receive a wire transfer.

COMMUNITY HEALTH

To qualify for community health, you will need to have your income verified. A pay-check stub is needed to prove income guidelines.

- Immunization – children's and flu shots
- Nutrition counseling
- Referrals for car seats
- Food stamps
- WIC vouchers are given to pregnant moms, nursing moms, babies to age 5 (includes milk, eggs, cheese, rice, cereal, juice).



Baby care program – moms meet once a month to ask questions on baby care.
