- Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all amateur golfers age 18 and older who have an established GHIN Golf Handicap Index. The **July 1st, 2013** index will be used for this tournament. Two-person teams/couples must be made up of one male and one female player.
- Entry fees:** **\$120.00** per team (\$60.00each) includes green fees and awards. **DOES NOT INCLUDE POWER CARTS.** Make your own reservation for a cart by calling the Golf Course at (916) 991-6875. Deadline for entry is Sunday, June 30th, 2013. No refunds after this date. Please call Bob Roak, Tournament Director, at 916-996-8259 regarding cancellations or refunds. Please **DO NOT** call the golf shop. Submission of an entry indicates willingness on the part of the player to abide by the rules and decisions of the Tournament Committee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for all returned checks.
- Format:** Play will be 18-holes of golf. Each competitor must secure his/her team playing partner. The maximum handicap difference between partners shall not exceed 20 strokes. Two teams may be paired together if requested. The CHAPMAN FORMAT, patterned after foursome play will be used. For example: Both partners hit from their own 1st tee. Then, each plays a second shot with the others ball. After the second shots, a choice is made regarding the ball to be used, and the hole is completed using alternate shots with the selected ball. (Hit, Switch & Choose).
- Awards:** The team with the Low Net over the field will be declared the 2013 Sacramento County Mixed Scotch Champions and will have their names inscribed on the Tournament Perpetual Trophy and receive Certificate Awards. Other Awards include a Low Gross Award and Flight Awards distributed within each Flight. Presentation will take place immediately following the conclusion of the tournament. All winners are requested to be present.
- Rules:** All play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf, and Local Rules posted by the Tournament Committee. In the absence of a Rules Official, competitors shall use Rule 3-3 by playing a second ball and referring any disputes to the Tournament Committee for resolution. The Tournament Committee shall decide all disputes and decisions made shall be final. NOTE: Teams shall be responsible for returning their own signed and attested scorecard at completion of play (Rule 6-6b). The use of Cellular phones/pagers or any similar equipment during competition is prohibited. However, use of GPS Range and Distance finders is acceptable.
- Starting Times/Check-in:** Players **MUST** check-in at least 15 minutes prior to assigned starting time. All times will be posted at the Golf Shop and on the SGC website at www.sacgolfcouncil.org one week prior to the event. You may call the Golf Shop after the deadline to confirm your tee-time at 916-991-6875, or you may call the Tournament Director (Bob Roak) at 916-996-8259 for help.
