International Financial Markets (UK / EU)

The recent financial and state's debt crisis resulted in serious turmoil within the international financial markets. These lead politicians and governments to demand many new supervisory mechanisms and additional control.

At the European level, governments have agreed to create a banking union. There is no doubt that a central supervisory mechanism should be established at the European Central Bank. But some questions remain open and subject to dispute: how will banks - when bankrupt - be shut down in the future, and who should render a decision in such cases?

With the banking union, governments have taken the next step towards European integration. However, it is not apparent how non-euro zone states will position themselves in this respect.

After the establishment of the new German government, it remains to be seen, whether these or other topics, e.g. the reform of the EU, as the UK in particular is requesting, will be focussed upon. Also, it is unclear, whether Germany and the UK will cooperate in these topics or whether the positions will grow further apart in 2014.
