Tech Trailblazers is a new afterschool technology education program. It's for students in grades 6 through 9 who want to learn more about computers and explore careers in technology, but don't have access to a computer of their own. Starts March 2! Meets for five weeks on Wednesdays, from 3:30 to 6:30 pm. In the last class (April 13) students build their own computer to take home.

What students will learn: Each week students will have both classroom and hands-on training:



Week 1: Hardware – What are the parts inside a computer? How do they work? *Hands-on:* Take apart a computer and see how it works. Recycle old computers.



Week 2: Connections – How do parts and peripherals work together? *Hands-on:* Assemble parts and repair a computer.



Week 3: Software – What's an operating system? How do programs work? *Hands-on:* Install a Linux operating system and test programs.



Week 4: Networking and the Internet – How do computers communicate? *Hands-on:* Test wired and Wifi Internet connections and other hardware.



Week 5: Build a computer to take home!

Hands-on: Students build their own desktop computer using everything they've learned!

Program eligibility: Students are eligible to apply if they do not have convenient and consistent access to a working home computer and are interested in learning more about technology. At the end of the program, students will receive a refurbished desktop computer with the UberMix operating system.
