



<u>Concept Development Workshop for Trials and</u> <u>Translational Research Studies</u>

Friday 25th November 2011

This one day workshop will help clinical investigators refine their concept for the evaluation of an intervention into a proposal for a clinical trial and/or translational research study. It will provide information, advice and guidance on how to develop a concept outline from an initial idea or clinical question by specifying a suitable aim, objectives, population, interventions, study design, outcome measures, sample size, analysis plan and funding strategy, as well as further tips and hints on developing your proposal into a funding application, letter of intent (LOI) and full study protocol.

Who should attend?

This workshop is designed for investigators (clinicians & scientists) who have an idea for a clinical trial and are suitably qualified individuals pursuing clinical research. Investigators from any therapeutic area or discipline are able to attend.

A fee of \$100 will be payable at registration to offset administrative costs. Those developing Oncology proposals may apply for a workshop scholarship. What should you do to prepare?

Each participant will be required to bring a concept outline for a study or a protocol currently being written. This will be developed further during the workshop. A one page draft concept outline for your study must be submitted for review by the workshop faculty by COB Friday 11th November 2011

The workshop faculty based at the NHMRC Clinical Trials Centre has extensive experience and expertise in the development of clinical trials, teaching clinical trials and translational research methods, statistical design and analyses.

The program will include a number of interactive sessions and topics including:

- Structure and Purpose of a Concept Outline
- Developing a Health Intervention
- Trial Design and Sample Size Calculations
- Specifying Suitable Target Populations
- Outcomes
- Feasibility and Funding Strategies

The program format will consist of a combination of presentations, exercises and interactive group discussions. Participants will work on their proposed concepts throughout the day and present them for discussion and feedback in small group sessions supported by faculty experts.
