THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

We have heard today’s Gospel passage over and over again when Jesus asks “Who do people say the Son of Man is?” After Peter gives other people’s opinions Jesus asks for his personal answer, and he responds by saying: “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” And then the question is put to us: “Who do you and I say Jesus is?” So far there is nothing really new here. What may well be new is how we answer the question today compared to how we may have answered it before. We have experienced more of life with further successes and disappointments, failings, forgiveness (both asked for and needed), as well as blessings, and prayer that has been answered and some for which we have seen no answer (at least an answer that is acceptable to us). With different experiences in life who Jesus is to us may have shifted or changed.

So all along the way we need to respond again and again to the question of Jesus’ identity and place in our lives. Hopefully he means more to us, but the truth is that we may have more questions and even be more distanced from him because of things that have happened. Jesus told Peter that he hasn’t figured this out on his own, but that it has been revealed to him by his heavenly Father. We can ask for that same revelation that we will come to know the fullness of Christ in our lives as our lives continue to unfold.

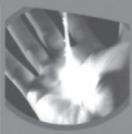

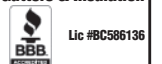
