



Dear friends of Israel:

During his recent visit to Israel, the US special envoy to the Middle East, George Mitchell, said that a comprehensive peace in the region is one of President Obama's top priorities. The appointment of Mitchell is a proof that a solution of the Middle East conflict is of the utmost importance for the Obama administration. In the past Mitchell already has distinguished himself as a determined negotiator. Several years ago he brought about a peace agreement between the hostile parties in Northern Ireland. Moreover, the Israel trips of US Defense Secretary Robert Gates and National Security Advisor Jim Jones also indicate that Israel and the Middle East are really important to President Obama.

During their meetings, the politicians also talked about the Jewish settlements in the so-called West Bank and in East Jerusalem. In defiance of the American request that Israel stop all construction in Palestinian territories, Prime Minister Netanyahu has just approved a building project in East Jerusalem. Netanyahu obviously wanted to demonstrate that Jerusalem will not be divided again and that the Jews have a right to erect buildings everywhere—not only in Jerusalem, but also in the West Bank. Concerning the Jewish settlements in the latter area, Netanyahu declared that it would not be acceptable if a future Palestinian state were “judenrein” (free of Jews). The Jewish settlements in the West Bank could become a measuring stone for

the willingness of the Palestinians to accept a peaceful coexistence with their Jewish neighbors.

President Obama's personal objective vision includes Israel and the Palestinians, Syria, Lebanon and the surrounding region. Mitchell stressed that the US's “commitment to Israel's security is unshakable and will not change.” He also said that the current strains in the US-Israel ties are “discussions among friends” that can be resolved. In his meetings with several Arab leaders, Mitchell emphasized that America expects definite steps toward a normalization of Arab-Israeli relations and that the Arab side should “refrain from any words or deeds that make the prospect of successful negotiations more difficult.”

This new American peace effort seems to be more determined than the previous ones. The fact that President Obama has declared a peace in the Middle East to be his personal objective puts further weight on the endeavor. This development fits well into the prophetic picture that has often been presented in this magazine. Mitchell's urgent appeal to all parties involved not to provoke any further discord may lead to a peace agreement. However, such a solution will not remove the profound differences between the parties involved. This is why the prophet Zechariah talks about a future partition of Jerusalem with half of the city going into exile (Zech 14:2). When this comes to pass, however, the Lord Himself will intervene and join the battle (verse 3). The urgency that Obama shows in his effort to achieve a solution of the Middle East conflict shows how quickly we are approaching the conditions prior to the return of our Lord Jesus.

Sharing with you the assurance that our redemption is drawing near, I send you a warm Shalom,

MOSES, JESUS AND THE FUTURE OF ISRAEL: PART 2

Just as Joseph, David, Solomon and a few judges are types of Christ, we also see in the life of Moses parallels that apply to Jesus. Let us consider these and the future of Israel in a three-part series. This is Part 2.

What God's messengers were imperfect examples of in the Old Testament, Jesus was in a perfect way during His life on earth. We see prophetically in His life and that of the people of Israel how the situation of Israel will be before the second coming of Jesus.

The Parallels, Part 2

27. Moses was the representative of the old covenant (Exodus 34:27). Jesus is the mediator of the new covenant (Hebrews 9:15). "For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ" (John 1:17).
28. Moses is the giver of the Ten Commandments; Jesus is the giver of the new commandment: "A

new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another" (John 13:34), and, "If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love" (John 15:10).

29. Just as Moses "rose up early in the morning" and built an altar to the Lord, we read of Jesus that He rose up early in the morning to pray and to bring His own body as an altar before God, "And Moses wrote all the words of the Lord, and rose up early in the morning, and builded an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars, according to

the twelve tribes of Israel” (Exodus 24:4), and, “In the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed” (Mark 1:35).

30. Both Moses and the Lord spoke prophetically about the future of Israel and her dispersion (Matthew 24), and, “...The Lord shall scatter thee among all people, from the one end of the earth even unto the other; and there thou shalt serve

other gods, which neither thou nor thy fathers have known, even wood and stone” (Deuteronomy 28:64, cf. 29:14).

31. Just as Moses spoke of Israel’s tribulation at the end of days shortly before the end of his life, Jesus also did this in Matthew 24, “When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to the Lord thy God, and shall be obedient unto his voice...” (Deuteronomy 4:30), and, “For I know that after my death ye will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because ye will do evil in the sight of the Lord, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands” (Deuteronomy 31:29).

32. The people of Israel believed in God and in Moses. Jesus called upon His disciples to believe in God and in Him, “And Israel saw that great work which the Lord did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the Lord, and believed the Lord, and his servant Moses” (Exodus 14:31), and, “Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me” (John 14:1).

33. Moses had 70 helpers, and Jesus also had 70 helpers (Numbers 11:16-17 and Luke 10:1).

34. Moses initiated the Passover and kept it until the liberation of Israel from Egypt, “And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the Lord hath made with you concerning all these words” (Exodus 24:8, cf. Hebrews 11:28). Jesus initiated the celebration of Holy

Communion in His blood and became Himself the Passover Lamb for our liberation, “And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many” (Mark 14:24).

35. As Moses instituted the Feast of the Passover as a remembrance, so the Lord instituted Holy Communion as a remembrance of His death (Exodus 12:14 and Luke 22:19).

36. Both Moses and Joshua appeared in Israel again after their death, “And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him” (Matthew 17:3), and, “...To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God” (Acts 1:3).

37. Moses was faithful and did

what God told him to do. Our Lord Jesus was absolutely faithful to His Father, “Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house. For this man was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house. For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God. And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after; but Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end” (Hebrews 3:1-6).

38. Moses was the meekest

man on earth, “Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth” (Numbers 12:3). Jesus said of Himself, “Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls” (Matthew 11:29).

39. When two of the elders in Israel prophesied in the Spirit of God—although they did not go outside the camp, in according with Moses’ orders, but stayed within the camp—Joshua, Moses’ servant, complained, but Moses answered, “Enviest thou for my sake? Would God that all the Lord’s people were prophets, and that the Lord would put his spirit upon them!” (Numbers 11:29). And the Lord said once to His disciples when they forbade someone to cast out demons in the name of Jesus, “Forbid him not: for he that is not

against us is for us” (Luke 9:50).

40. When the “sons of Korah” arose against him, Moses was able to point them to his “impeccable” life, although he was not without sin, “And Moses was very wroth, and said unto the Lord, Respect not their offering: I have not taken one ass from them, neither have I hurt one of them” (Numbers 16:15). Jesus was without sin, and when the elders of the people arose against Him, He could point to Himself and say, “Which of you convinceth me of sin?” (John 8:46).

41. Moses had finished his work at the end of his life, “And he reared up the court round about the tabernacle and the altar, and set up the hanging of the court gate. So Moses finished the work” (Exodus 40:33). Jesus said, “My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to

finish his work” (John 4:34). And at the end of His life, the Lord said, “It is finished” in John 19:30.

42. Moses only saw the Promised Land from afar, and did not experience the taking possession of it, but later on he appeared in glory on the Mount of Transfiguration in Israel. Similarly, Jesus saw the kingdom of God from afar, but will not set it up until He returns in glory.

43. Moses prayed to be able to enter into the Promised Land and not die beforehand, but He bowed himself to the will of God (Deuteronomy 3:24-26). Jesus prayed that the cup might pass Him by, but He submitted His own will to the will of the Father (Luke 22:42).

44. Moses appointed Joshua as his successor, while Jesus appointed His disciples to be His “successors.”

As Moses “stood in the breach” (Psalm 106:23) for the people, Jesus stood in the breach in a perfect way for all mankind by dying on the cross for us.



45. Moses passed on the Holy Spirit to his successor, Joshua, “And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom (Scofield Bible margin: Holy Spirit); for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the Lord commanded Moses” (Deuteronomy 34:9). The Lord did this similarly with His apostles, “And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy

Ghost” (John 20:22).

46. As Moses “stood in the breach” (Psalm 106:23) for the people, Jesus stood in the breach in a perfect way for all mankind by dying on the cross for us.

47. Moses rejected the glory and riches of Egypt; he counted the “reproach of Christ” greater riches, and looked to the reward God would give him. His poverty in the wilderness led the people to the riches of the Promised Land (Hebrews 11:24-26). Jesus rejected the kingdoms and riches of this world that the devil offered Him. He bore His cross, and through His poverty we were made rich (Luke 4:1-13 and 2 Corinthians 8:9).

48. Moses, as a son of the daughter of Pharaoh, was like Pharaoh, but he left

this “glory.” Jesus did not think it robbery to be equal with God but forsook His glory (Philippians 2:6-8).

49. Moses “...endured, as seeing him who is invisible” (Hebrews 11:27). In the same way, Jesus always had His Father before His eyes, “The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise” John 5:19, cf. John 8:38).

50. Moses said to the people at God’s command, “Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord your God which I command you” (Deuteronomy 4:2). Jesus said a similar thing in Revelation 22:18-19, “For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto

these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: and if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.”

51. Through the signs in Egypt, the people of Israel came to true faith in God and in Moses, “And Israel saw that great work which the Lord did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the Lord, and believed the Lord, and his servant Moses” (Exodus 14:31, cf. Exodus 19:9). In the same way, many people in Israel at the time of Jesus came to believe in God and Jesus Christ through the signs that He did, “Now when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover, in the feast day, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did” (John 2:23).

52. Moses was confirmed as God's representative and as the liberator of Israel through the 10 miracles (plagues) that he did, culminating in the death of all the firstborn. Jesus was confirmed as the Messiah in Matthew 8-9 through 10 miracles (healings), to which raising a man from the dead belonged.
53. After the liberation out of Egypt, the Israelites sang the song of Moses, in Exodus 15. In Revelation 15:3, the song of Moses, and after that the song of the Lamb is sung, "And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvelous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints."
54. Moses is called the "servant of God" (Exodus 14:31 and Revelation 15:3), just as Jesus in Acts 3:13 (NIV).
55. God answered Moses in Exodus 19:19, "Moses spake, and God answered him by a voice." He also did this with Jesus in John 12:28, "Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again."
56. Moses spoke with God face to face (Exodus 33:11). We can also say this of Jesus.
57. Just as Moses was on the mountain of God for a while, had fellowship with God and then returned, Jesus is now by the Father and will return. Therein a picture is given us of the situation of Israel and the world before the return of Jesus. We will be considering this endtimes example in the third and last part of this series.

BMI Airline Wipes Israel Off the Map

Cheap British carrier BMI, which recently launched lines flying to Tel Aviv, deleted Israel from electronic maps presented to passengers on its flights so as not to offend Islam, Army Radio reported.



However, the orientation of Mecca, the direction to which Muslim face when they pray, is shown on the electronic screens. In the electronic maps presented on BMI flights to Tel Aviv, Israel or any of its cities are not marked, except for Haifa, which is spelled "Khefa," a transliteration of the Arab name of the city as it was called before 1948.

BMI operates many lines to Muslim destinations and presents the "Mecca Compass" as a service to its many Muslim passengers. The company holds services from England

to Syria, Lebanon and Iran, among other Muslim destinations.

Recently BMI signed an agreement with the Tourism Ministry in order to add Israel to its roster of destinations.

The company said in response that two planes flying to Tel Aviv were originally intended to arrive in Arab countries and therefore the map was tailored to the passengers and showed mainly sites holy to Muslims.

A "logistic failure" caused the map to be presented on

the flight to Tel Aviv, a company statement said, and it will be removed from the planes flying to Tel Aviv. The company was making every effort not to hurt passengers' feelings by adopting a non-political position, the statement added.



Israel Helps India Launch Spy Satellite

India sent an intelligence-gathering satellite into space that was designed in Israel.



India launched the RISAT-2 satellite aboard a Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle. The satellite, developed by Israel Aerospace Industries, is based on a specially-designed technology called SAR (synthetic aperture radar) that enables the satellite to provide imagery 24 hours a day and under any weather conditions.

The new satellite bolsters India's presence in space. Last year, Israel launched the TECSAR satellite from India that, like the RISAT, uses radar to create high-resolution images. Israel also operates the Ofek 5, Ofek 7, Eros A and Eros B spy satellites.

According to reports in the Indian press, New Delhi asked Israel Aerospace Industries to speed up production of the satellite following the Mumbai terrorist attacks in November 2008 to keep an eye on its borders, stretching from Pakistan to China. The satellite can also be used to gather intelligence on Iran.

US WARNS ISRAEL

The U.S. administration has issued a stiff warning to Israel not to build in the area known as E-1, which lies between Jerusalem and the West Bank settlement of Ma'aleh Adumim. Any change in the status quo in E-1 would be "extremely damaging," even "corrosive," the message said.

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has vowed in the past to finally build the controversial E-1 housing project—as have several premiers before him, though none has done so due to American pressure. He opened his recent election campaign with a visit to Ma'aleh Adumim in which he declared: "I will link Jerusalem to Ma'aleh Adumim via the Mevasseret Adumim neighborhood, E-1. I want to see one continuous string of built-up Jewish neighborhoods."

years or so, Israeli agriculture technologies have been made to cope with whatever Mother Nature throws at them. It's taken special fans, software, innovative dew collectors, drip irrigation, integrated pest control tactics, and state of the art greenhouses along with some "mother of invention"—Israeli style.

As a means to survive in the hostile desert climate, Israeli agronomists, entrepreneurs, academics, and government agencies, started focusing on agriculture as a means to survive.

Over the years, Israel married pure science with know how and technology, and today the country exports more agriculture technologies than the fresh produce which inspired the innovations in the first place.

Israeli technologies cover just about "whatever you may think of," Agritech co-chair Arie Regev tells ISRAEL21c. "There will be irrigation technology, monitor control equipment, milking parlor equipment, assisting equipment, computers, monitors and software."

"Israel is having, keeping and maintaining modern advanced agriculture in arid and semiarid conditions where water constraints are very imminent and strong, and where temperature and humidity is high," Regev says. "Many of our solutions for crops or for livestock provide solutions to alleviate this problem, making growing crops and raising livestock, easier, better

and more efficient. And, yes, more humane concerning animal husbandry."

Space Age and Tested on Mars

One solution that Israelis have had a hand in distributing around the world is a new ground humidity-monitoring sensor developed for NASA's spaceship Phoenix. The Israeli company Agrolan is distributing this particular product for use in agriculture.

On Mars the sensors were attached to robotic arms so the spacecraft could identify water. On Earth, Agrolan's technology can measure soil humidity for farmers over large swathes of land. The collected data is transmitted to a specific website so that the software can control in real time the timing and the quantity of the irrigation, says Dan Meiri, the general manger of Agritech.

Innovative solutions include those launched by Shelef Laboratories, which has built a mobile lab for monitoring pests and pesticides applied to large commercial scale farms;

or how about colored canvases developed by Israel's Volcani Institute to cover your crops, filtering out certain kinds of light to disorient pests?

"Tal Ya Water technologies, a semi-startup, is still having money invested in it, but according to what I know, it's a very nice company," Meiri tells ISRAEL21c. "They are collecting dew in a nice and simple way—like from the time of the Nabateans—but their secret is the shape of sheets they are using and materials. They've waited a long time before they released their method."

"There is another unique company—a new system developed by Auto Agronom that is detecting each parameter on the leaves of plants. Not just how much water or fertilizer is there, but oxygen and carbon dioxide too," adds Meiri.

Israel is active and well known for its work in agriculture and humanitarian affairs, and its agricultural technology transfer is important in

developing countries. Some successes are Israel's low-pressure irrigation systems in South Africa, a unique aquaculture enterprise in Uganda, an Israeli-made rural development project in Angola, or dairy farms that it has helped established in Eastern Europe.

"In Israel, we have a foreign ministry and a ministry of agriculture working to specifically find ways for Israeli technology to help other countries," said Hebrew University of Jerusalem's Prof. Ayal Kimhi, who is also Israel's director of research, at the Center for Agricultural Economic Research.

"Doing this kind of work helps to broaden people's perception of Israel, seeing that it's a superpower in technology, not just a land from the

bible or what you see on CNN," said Kimhi.

Nokdim is a communal settlement and Israeli settlement located south of Bethlehem in the northern Judean hills of the West Bank. The population is 650.

Nokdim was founded on July 5, 1982 by residents of Tekoa, and is within the municipal jurisdiction of the Gush Etzion Regional Council. Nokdim was originally named *Ei-David* in memory of two residents of Tekoa—Eli Pressman, a new immigrant from France who was killed in the 1982 Lebanon War, and David Rosenfeld, manager of the museum and tourist site at Herodium who was murdered in July 1982 by two of his Palestinian employees.

The name was changed to *Nokdim* in reference to the shepherding prophet Amos who lived in nearby biblical Tekoa.

Nokdim is a mixed community of religious and secular Jews, home to native Israelis and immigrants. Some 140 families live in Nokdim.



Wikipedia Editors: Coverage of Israel 'Problematic'

Wikipedia's coverage of Israel-related issues is "problematic," leading Israeli internet researchers claimed at the Wikipedia Academy 2009 Conference dealing with the world's largest encyclopedia.

The conference was organized by Wikimedia's volunteer-based Israel chapter and Tel Aviv University's Netvision Institute for Internet Studies. However, the Web site's leading manager said it merely reflected public discourse.

In demonstrating what he defined as problems, Eli Hacohen, the Institute's director, showed how Hamas is not defined as a terrorist organization in the first paragraph describing the organization on the English site of the reader-edited online encyclopedia, which is the world's fourth most popular Web site. Hacohen also documented his attempts to define Iran's president, Mahmoud Ahmadinejad,



as a Holocaust-denier. Each time he included his remarks on Wikipedia, users and editors removed the reference—despite Ahmadinejad's frequent and public Holocaust denials.

On a related entry, Hacohen also noted that Wikipedia defines David Irving—a known Holocaust denier—as a historian, although his credentials are recognized by no one but himself. Furthermore, the Wikipedia entry on January's Operation Cast Lead in Gaza describes it as an "intense bombardment" by Israel on a civilian population.

Dror Kamir, a leading Israeli Wikipedia promoter, showed how Lod is not listed as a city in Israel in Wikipedia's Arabic-language version.

Nanotech Will Change the World

Although he was unable to attend Israel's first international conference on nanotechnology in Jerusalem because of his state visit to the Czech Republic, President Shimon Peres would have relished the fact that there were 800 participants—150 of them from abroad and many at the top of their fields.

Peres declared that nanotechnology "offers great promise to all humankind.

Nothing is new in nano; what is new is that we have discovered it... All things existed before, but we weren't able to see it."

One nanometer is one-billionth of a meter, and nanotech involves the development of new materials, structures or objects up to 100 nanometers in size either by the "bottom up" approach in which atoms or molecules assemble themselves under chemical, electri-

cal or other influences, or a "top-down" approach in which nanosized objects are cut down from larger entities.

One such innovation is the "nano nose" developed by Tel Aviv University chemistry Prof. Doron Shabat. Using molecular techniques in nanotechnology, he developed new molecules that can magnify weak traces of minuscule substances such as pollution in water or explosives, as well as biomarkers in cancer, by "sniffing" them out. The "bionic nose" is actually a molecular sensor that can amplify such substances tenfold and make them detectable. The prototype is ready and will be used experimentally to improve healthcare, safety and security.

Dan Vilenski of the Israel National Nanotechnology Initiative (INNI) compared the potential of nano today with that of semiconductors after World War II. "Then, people said semiconductors would never contribute to mankind, but now it is a trillion-dollar industry."

INNI, he said, wants to persuade decision makers and industry that nano is a real business here with a great potential, worthy of commercial investment along with research and development in the academic world.


