8. Students wanting 9 courses must submit an Additional Course Load Request form to the office on Friday, March 4th.
9. Grade 10-12 students **may not** register for Grade 9 option courses, except for students in the late entry vocational program (Fashion Technology & Building Construction/Carpentry).
