# **Packing List and Other Helpful Information:**

**DO bring:** Bible & Pen, Sleeping Bag & Pillow, Clothes for 6 days, game clothes (t-shirts and gym/sport shorts that can get wet and/or messy) Toiletries, Beach & Bath Towels, a Flashlight, Light Jacket, one pair of jeans (in case it gets cool), Extra shoes, flip flops, a Swimsuit (girl's swimsuits should completely cover their midriff and back), Sunscreen, Insect repellent, over-the-counter medications (Tylenol, Benadryl, etc), Money for extra activities (see below if interested), enough cash for snacks, and bring friends!

→ PLEASE CLEARLY LABEL ALL YOUR PERSONAL ITEMS, so you know what's yours and what is not!

**Do NOT bring:** Inappropriate clothing (no crude or obscene writing or pictures or clothing that is immodest. Please do not bring tight or revealing clothing (such as wearing leggings in place of pants, wearing shorts that are shorter than mid-thigh, or clothes with lots of holes in them). No drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons (this includes air soft and paintball guns), fireworks, mp3 players, hand-held video games, or bad attitudes. Cell phones *cannot* be out or used at any point during the week or they will be confiscated and returned at the end of camp. It is a better idea to not bring them at all.

### **Camp Activities Available for Additional Cost:**

There are more than enough activities available that are included in the camp cost to satisfy kids at camp, but the activities below are also available for an extra cost. Students will need to bring **EXACT** change for these activities, as there will not be anyone to make change for them. Money is due at the time of the event. The best idea is to put the cash in an envelope and label it for the activity.

## **Rules for Summer Camp:**

(We require parents and students to read these rules together before camp and talk to John at <a href="mailto:jvanne@gracepres.org">jvanne@gracepres.org</a> or Ryan at <a href="mailto:rhaggerty@gracepres.org">rhaggerty@gracepres.org</a> if there are any questions or concerns)

- 1. Fireworks, alcohol, cigarettes, weapons, drugs, and matches/lighters are not permitted.
- 2. Cell phones, hand-held video games, mp3 players, etc, are not permitted at camp. If we see them, we will confiscate them until we are back at the church at the end of camp. If there is an emergency, students will be able to use leaders' cell phones or a camp phone to call home. Parents will likewise be given the Lake Geneva contact number if there is an emergency on their end and they need to contact their child.
- 3. Respect the camp and the facilities. Any damages caused by students will be charged to the student or family of that student.
- 4. Students are required to pick up after themselves and others. Do not litter outside, and place all trash in a trash can. If you see trash lying around, please pick it up and help us out this week.
- 5. Respect your leaders. Their word is final. If one leader says no, all leaders will say no.
- 6. Please follow orders when they are given to you as an individual and as part of a group. Bad attitudes and bad examples are contagious...don't take away from what we are trying to accomplish this week. Watch your attitude and actions. Treat others as you would like to be treated.
- 7. Remember we are here as a group. No guy/girl pairing off or inappropriate behavior will be tolerated. Any flirtatious activity or touching will be put to a stop and if it continues to occur, parents will be called.
- 8. Extended hugging or lounging on each other is not allowed. This rule is for same-gender friends as well. We want to set a high standard of purity and not become stumbling blocks to anyone.
- 9. Guys and girls are not to be in each other's cabins at any time. Guys are allowed in the Maples lounge until 10pm.
- 10. Be at all scheduled meals, meetings, and activities. Failure to do so will be met with penalties for your team and other disciplinary actions.
- 11. You cannot leave camp at any time during the week (even to go running in the morning). If you do want to wake up early and walk or run around camp, you need to get approval from your cabin leader the night before.
- 12. Lights out means lights out. No leaving cabins without permission from a leader. Failure to comply will be met with penalties for your team and other disciplinary actions.
- 13. Don't mess with other people's stuff. If you are found to have stolen something your parents and possibly even the police will be called.
- 14. We will not tolerate bullying, fighting, or gossip. If we see these things, disciplinary actions will be taken.
- 15. We reserve the right to call parents in dealing students who break rules, as well as having parents come and pick their child up early from camp if there is a repeated problem with rule breaking.
- 16. Remember you are a testimony to the camp and others. You represent Grace Pres. and more importantly, Jesus Christ.
