

## **BID #2359 - SALE OF COMPOST**

The City of Westfield's Department of Health has approximately 2000 cubic yards of unscreened compost derived from the 2010/2011 municipal leaf and grass clippings collection and composting program. No chemical analysis of this compost is being planned.

The City of Westfield intends to sell the compost to the bidder that offers the highest bid that is deemed acceptable by the City. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

The material for sale is offered "as is". The City of Westfield makes no warranty concerning the material. Bidders are responsible for examining the material prior to bidding and are urged to do so. The material may need to be screened at the discretion of the buyer off-site and at his/her own expense. Material must be loaded onsite by the buyer onto the buyer's vehicle during operational hours.

The successful bidder is expected to give full payment within forty-eight hours of the bid award and have the compost removed from the premises within fourteen (14) days after the bid award. Exact Cash, Certified Check or Money Order made out to the City of Westfield are the only acceptable method of payment.
