Minutes of the Casitas Municipal Water District Board Meeting Held July 28, 2010

A meeting of the Board of Directors was held July 28, 2010 at Casitas' Office, Oak View, California. Directors Kaiser, Baggerly, Word and Hicks were present. Director Handley was absent. Also present were Steve Wickstrum, General Manager, Rebekah Vieira, Clerk of the Board, and Attorney, Bob Krimmer. There was one staff member and no members of the public in attendance. Director Kaiser led the group in the flag salute.

1. Public comments.

General Manager comments.

Mr. Wickstrum reported that he and Director Word attended a Ventura City Council meeting and workshop on July 26th. Ron Calkins provided a presentation of the City's water and sewer departments. Key issues are redevelopment of water resources, maximizing water supplies and retain state water entitlement as an ace in the hole. There is an issue of groundwater rights being sold out from underneath them as irrigation lands convert to residential. The City wants to retain the rights. They also discussed having a pass through of costs to customers with increased pumping costs. Water conservation is also a key issue for them. They have had 20% reduction from 1970 use to current use. Other issues are storm water permit activities and they are exploring waste to energy projects at the sanitation plant. It was informative for us to be there.

Mr. Wickstrum informed the Board that he would be out from August 12 through the end of the month and questioned the need for the second board meeting in August. The board also discussed various committee meetings and at this point they will be postponed unless there is an emergency.

Director Hicks congratulated Jim on the AWA BBW. Director Word thanked Carol and the Recreation/Maintenance staff as they did an excellent job preparing for the BBQ.

Director Kaiser asked if the Ojai Chamber had scheduled a meeting to be held at the Lake. Park Services Manager Carol Belser replied that it was scheduled for October 27, 2011. Director Kaiser asked if our fixtures at the district are 1.28 or less. Mr. Wickstrum explained that we have a variety of low flow fixtures and have recently installed a new stealth one in the ladies restroom.

8. <u>Discussion regarding repayment of the 2000 Casitas Dam Seismic Modernization Project.</u>

Mr. Wickstrum explained that, after a long delay, the District received a request from the Bureau to resume discussions on the repayment of safety of dam work that was performed at Casitas Dam. There is a long history on this project. It started in 1998 with a series of approaches from the Bureau requesting Casitas to sign a blank contract and technical sessions afterwards to determine costs and our obligations to take care of those costs. The Bureau last addressed this with the District in 2008 when we received a letter outlining the total costs of the project but a month later got a phone call stating the costs that were presented were incorrect. Now, a few years later a new staff member is coming up to speed with the repayment issues. I discussed this on Monday with the new staff member and reminded her of the ability to pay study which the Bureau had agreed to conduct. For the last ten years the District has provided our crop report information to the Bureau to assist in their analysis on the ability of irrigation customer's to pay for their portion of the SOD modifications. The

District has paid the M&I portion and paid interest accrued during construction. The District wishes to work with the Bureau to finish this project and I have requested a meeting with them to do so.

SUBJECT: USGS-CMWD Cooperative Stream Gaging Program for November 1,

2010 to October 31, 2011 - Ventura River near Ventura Gaging Station

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors approve continuing the cooperative stream gaging program with the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) for the Ventura River near Ventura station and authorize and direct the General Manager to sign and send the Joint Funding Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Since 1961 Casitas and the USGS have maintained agreements for the USGS operation of various stream and reservoir gaging stations within the District. In 1988, Casitas assumed the operation of all subject stations, with the exception of the Ventura River near Ventura gaging station that is located near the Foster Park Bridge. The USGS has reliably provided Casitas, City of Ventura and Ventura County with information gathered from this key gaging station.

Attached is a letter from the U.S. Geological Survey dated June 16, 2010 that outlines the proposed source of funding for the gaging station program. The 2010-11 USGS cost sharing for the Station remains at 40% USGS – 60% Casitas and partners. The City of San Buenaventura (Ventura) and Ventura County Watershed Protection District (VCWPD) will continue to be partners with Casitas and divide the 60% equally.

The charges from USGS to Casitas for station operation shall be \$13,450, a \$150 increase from 2009-10. Ventura and VCWPD have confirmed that they will reimburse Casitas for one third of the station costs that are charged to Casitas by the USGS, bringing the actual station costs to about \$4484 each for Casitas, Ventura and VCWPD.

USGS is expected to provide four copies of a Joint Funding Agreement for Casitas to sign and return.

RESOLUTION DIRECTING EXECUTION OF A JOINT FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN UNITED STATES GEOLOGICAL SURVEY AND CASITAS MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Casitas Municipal Water District and the U.S. Geological Survey, U.S. Department of the Interior, have previously entered into a cooperative agreement involving matching funds covering the operation and maintenance of a certain stream gaging stations in the Ventura River watershed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that arrangements for the U.S. Geological Survey to perform the operation and maintenance of the Ventura River near Ventura stream gaging station during the November 1, 2010 to October 31, 2011 period; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Geological Survey has indicated that subject to the availability of Federal matching funds, the U.S. Geological Survey will provide \$8,950 in funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Casitas Municipal Water District that the General Manager is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of Casitas to sign the Joint Funding Agreement in the form provided by the U.S. Geological Survey, and request continuation of said cooperative arrangements during the period November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2011 at a fixed total cost of \$13,450 to Casitas. Further, direct staff to seek reimbursement of two-thirds of the \$13,450 upon receipt of the billing from the U.S. Geological Survey.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors approve the purchase order for Consolidated Electrical Distributors in the not to exceed amount of \$93,700 for the purchase of electrical motor control centers and associated electrical equipment for the Upper Ojai pump plant electrical upgrade project.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

The FY 2010/11 budget contains funds in the amount of \$115,000.00 for the purchase and delivery of the pump/motor control centers and associated equipment for the Upper Ojai pump plant electrical upgrade project.

In January 2009 the Board of Directors approved expenditures for an engineering consultant to perform a pump plant-by-pump plant evaluation of seven pumping facilities. The evaluation identified and estimated the costs to provide the necessary materials and actions to bring each plant from the Edison meter to the pump motors up to NEC and NFP 70E standards. The Upper Ojai Valley pump plant was identified as the second most critical facility in need of upgrading based on the urgency of electrical safety hazard repairs.

To date, two pump plants were competitively bid with Allen Bradley motor control centers selected in both cases. Motor control centers require both spare parts and specialized employee training. Motor control centers are expensive with an individual unit running from approximately \$50,000 to upwards of \$250,000 depending on the size of the pump motor. Each pump plant requires multiple motor control centers. Allen Bradley motor control centers have worked well with minimal problems.

Allen Bradley sells their equipment through distributors that have exclusive territories. Consolidated Electric Distributors (CED) of Ventura is the local Allen Bradley Distributor.

Staff recommends that the motor control centers be purchased under sole source designation from Allen Bradley through CED. The District's current program of maintaining a supply of Allen Bradley spare parts allows for the realization of life cycle cost savings and the minimizing of Operation's expense budget requirements.

The purchase order's total amount includes an estimated additional sum of \$1,100.00 for CED to provide shipping FOB job site.

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Fishing guide helps clients hit jackpot at Casitas

It's early morning at Lake Casitas. The sun bounces off the water as white puffy clouds float leisurely across the blue sky.

Most people would consider such a spot paradise, but for Ojai native Marc Mitrany it's just another day at the office.

Mitrany, 42, is owner of Ojai Angler Professional Fishing Guide Services, a company he founded 14 years ago.

He started it to share his experience and fishing knowledge with anglers from around the world who come to Lake Casitas looking to haul in a big bass or some other species that inhabits the lake.

"I feel blessed and fortunate to be able to do this for a living," Mitrany said. "It's a passion.

"I am as excited to see someone else catch a fish as I am catching one myself."

Mitrany has fished all over the world, appearing regularly with Keith Covey of World Wide Fishing Guide on various programs broadcast on the Outdoor Channel.

But for Mitrany, nothing is more enjoyable than being out on the water at Lake Casitas, helping others enjoy its many gifts.

"It's one of the most beautiful spots in the world," Mitrany said of his hometown lake.

Mitrany uses his vast knowledge of the lake and its "hot spots" to help his clients hit the fish jackpot.

As they motor out to begin their quest, Mitrany plays the role of tour guide, sharing insights about the lake and it various inhabitants. He points out that this same lake hosted the rowing competition for the 1984 Summer Olympics. He talks about the fact over 100 species of birds can be found around and on the lake.

"It's an amazing place and I want to share that fact," Mitrany said. "I try to educate as well, teach a little conservation so we can try to protect this great natural resource we have."

While his goal is to help every angler catch as many fish as possible, Mitrany urges all his clients to catch and release, believing it's the right thing to do to make sure future generations have the chance to enjoy fishing the same lake.

While most of his clients are novice anglers, he's open to taking out all levels of fishermen.

"I feel I can help even a really experienced angler because of the things I have learned both as a guide and from my own fishing experiences," Mitrany said.

Westlake Village residents Bill and Sandy Berger have gone on several trips with Mitrany. Bill Berger says he's fished with guides all over the world, but few compare to the skill Mitrany offers.

With their grandsons Mark and Chris Berger in town visiting from Santa Fe, N.M., the Bergers decided to have Mitrany show the boys a thing or two about fishing.

During a four-hour trip, Mitrany helped each boy haul in a bass. Both agreed to release their catch after having their photos taken as a memento of the day.

"He's a great guide and he gave us a lot of great tips," Mark Berger said.

"He showed us how to put a finger on top of the rod for feeling small twitches when a fish bites. It was really fun."

Mitrany's first fishing experience came at age 5 when his father Hal Mitrany took him to Lake Casitas to fish off the shore.

"I hooked a duck by accident," Mitrany said. "I thought that was pretty fun and how much more fun it would be to catch something you can't even see."

Mitrany didn't get into the business side of fishing for a while. He worked for 15 years as a manager in the catering department at the Ojai Valley Inn & Spa.

It was at the Inn that he came up with the idea to offer a guide service at Lake Casitas.

He dealt with corporate groups at the Inn and noticed them spending money to provide activities for people attending their gatherings.

So in 1996, he put together a proposal for the executive committee, suggesting he could provide guests with a fishing guide service.

With the help of his food and beverage manager, they went for it.

"I did this (guiding) in mornings and worked at the Inn at night," Mitrany said. "I did that for seven years."

Eventually he opted to focus on guiding full time. His business has had steady growth since then. He's hoping one day, his daughter Gracie, 8, or son Corbin, 4, will take over the family business. Both have already shown interest and aptitude for fishing.

Mitrany loves his job, but he admits he feels pressure every time he takes a group out.

He knows if they have success, it can lead to more business. But for Mitrany it's more personal than simply building his business.

"I love fishing and I want others to enjoy it too, and nothing is more enjoyable than catching fish," Mitrany said.
