WHAT TO DO:

Packs, Troops, Teams and Crews make arrangements with legitimate community distribution food agencies that warehouse and distribute the food to the needy at no cost. Emphasis is on non-perishable food most needed for nutrition, such as peanut butter, baby formula, complete packaged meals, and such canned goods as tuna, chunky soups, stews, meats, fruits, and vegetables.

HOW TO DO IT - EACH UNIT:

- 1) Names a Good Turn for America Unit Coordinator.

- Organizes specific bag drops and collection points and obtains approval from local units for drop and 3) collection areas to avoid duplicated efforts.
- 4) Picks up food cards at the district March Roundtable
- Distributes food cards Saturday, March 16, 2013 or before March 22nd to predetermined neighborhood 5) residents.

- 6) Collects food items in bags starting at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 23, 2013 and deliver full food bags to predetermined legitimate food banks or pantries.
