Year One Maths Homework

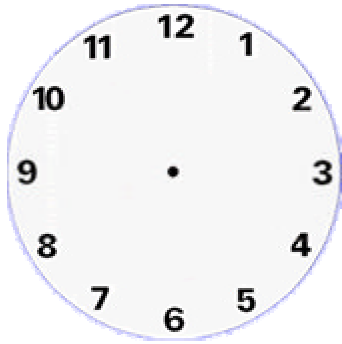


This homework relates to Maths work covered in class this week.

Children are learning to tell the time in terms of "o'clock" using analogue clocks. Help engineer the success of this activity, by ensuring children are recording times "on the hour".

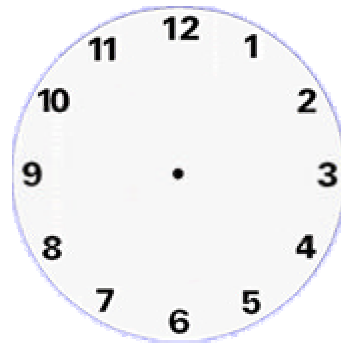
During the weekend, look at the time when you do different things. Draw the hands on the clock and then write the time.

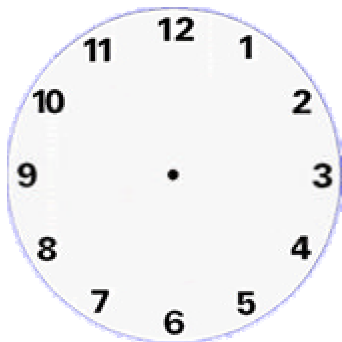

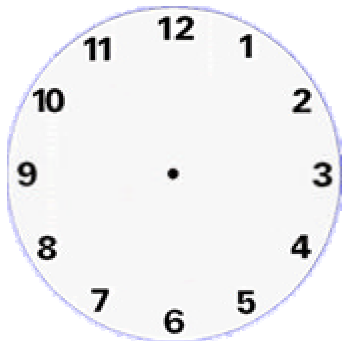

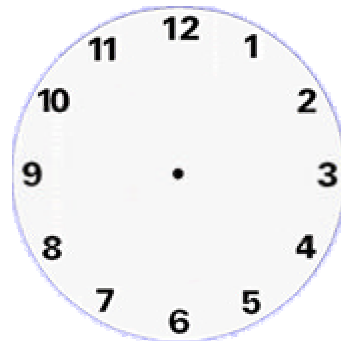
