Judging Rules & Criteria

1. The performance will be judged by a panel of 5 judges consisting of either dance instructors or dancers with insightful years' experience in dance. They are selected by the Competition Organizing Committee. The list of judges will be announced on website on January, 2009.

Once again, our website address is www.GAinternationalfolkfair.org.

- 2. The Judging Rules and Criteria are decided & set by the panel of judges assigned by the Azalea International Competition Organizing Committee.
- 3. The winners are decided by the top highest scores awarded by the judges based on the Judging Criteria. Each team's final score is calculated by averaging all five judges' scores for that team. Winners will be awarded from 1st to the 3rd (Youth and Adult Small Group) and to the 5th places (Adult Large Group).
- 4. In the event of a tie, judges will decide the winners based upon scores to item #1 in the Judging Criteria. Should a tie still remain, the scores to items #2 and #3 will be used to determine the winners.
 - **For both youth and adult teams, there will be only one winner for each place)
- 5. Winners will be recognized in the Valdosta Daily Times and on The Fun Channel.
- 6. The decision of the judges is final and binding.
- 7. At the end of the competition, all 5 judges' scores will be given to the team.

 The teams need to pick up their score sheets on site. We will not mail the sheets.
