## **Procedures to follow for optimum coverage:**

- 1. For Vessel: If your vessel is delayed, notify the IOC immediately (631-224-9141 ext 0).
- 2. For Contractor: At times, agents names and numbers are provided above in comments section. We suggest contacting them for updated ETA's, but always keep the IOC informed so that proper documentation can be made to log/case file.
- 3. For Vessel & Contractor: Vessel and contractor should make initial contact on site for coordination, such as reporting spill emergencies and to report hose on/hose off times. Exchange of cellular and/or VHF channels is critical. Contact information may be provided in the comments section above.
- 4. For Contractor: It is necessary for <u>all</u> contractors to have both cellular and radio capabilities. Also, attempt to get ship's seal and signature on all paperwork prior to departure. A activities log is recommended.
