WAF members enjoy the opportunity to present and receive feedback on their research in progress; to explore interdisciplinary research; to participate in developing research programs; and to draw on financial support for themselves and their most promising students.

WAF members contribute to the success of the Ostrom Workshop by regularly participating in the Colloquium Series; in grant proposal development; in supervising research teams; in offering courses in the field of governance; and in contributing to other research-related activities within a dynamic and stimulating community of scholars.

Application process

If you are interested in becoming a WAF, please follow these three steps:

- 1. Please review the Ostrom Workshop's Strategic Plan to understand our goals for the next three years. Consider how your involvement might relate to any of our strategic priorities and how your research and teaching efforts might benefit from being an active member in the Ostrom Workshop.
- 2. Please read the suggested activities below, which vary depending on whether or not you have an IU Bloomington affiliation.
- 3. Complete the affiliated faculty form on page 3 and send it to Allison Sturgeon (Executive Assistant and Grants Coordinator, sturgeon@iu.edu).

Suggested activities for IU Bloomington affiliates

- 1. Present ongoing research at the Colloquium Series, which is held every Monday at noon throughout the academic year.
- 2. Attend the Wednesday Research Series presented by visiting scholars and supported graduate students.
- 3. Serve as a mentor for visiting scholars.
- 4. Serve on a dissertation committee for our graduate students to share your expertise even if the dissertation is outside of your department.
- 5. Serve on internal committees. There are four committees from which to choose: Visiting Scholars Committee, Colloquium Series Committee, Research Funding Committee, and Graduate Student Funding Committee.
- 6. Route external funding proposals through the Ostrom Workshop.

Suggested activities for external affiliates

- 1. Host a graduate student as a visitor to your university for fieldwork or independent work under your tutorship.
- 2. Serve as dissertation reader and/or dissertation committee member for Ostrom Workshop affiliated doctoral students.
- 3. Offer a webinar on your research to the Colloquium Series, if traveling to Bloomington is not possible.
- 4. Co-PI on projects/proposals with external funding routed through the Ostrom Workshop.
