#### 3.90 Residence Access Line Retention Promotion

This promotion will offer eligible residential customers monthly bill credits of \$5.00 per line, on up to 2 lines. Customers may only receive this offer once per account.

Sheet: 51.149

Eligible customers are those residence customers who 1) have one or more access lines, call to disconnect at least one line, and then decide to retain the line or lines and 2) already have or newly purchase Caller ID Service (Calling Name Delivery and Calling Number Delivery).

Customers will receive \$5.00 per month for up to 30 months if they call to disconnect one line. Customers will receive a total of \$10.00 per month for up to 30 months if they call to disconnect two or more lines. As of February 1, 2009 customers will receive these benefits for up to 28 months. As of March 10, 2009 customers will receive these benefits for up to 24 months. The nonrecurring feature installation charge will be waived if the feature is newly purchased. The lines must be retained for a minimum, of 30 days.

Customers' bills will be credited each month that the line and feature are retained on the account. If customers disconnect an applicable line(s) or the required feature before the next bill period date in which a credit is due, any further benefits available under this offer will cease. If customers move from their current location, any further benefits under this offer will cease.

This offer cannot be combined with any other AT&T Texas residence retention offers. This offer is not available to customers who became a customer of AT&T Texas through a win-winback offer. This offer is not available to customers who purchase a newly introduced package on or after September 1, 2008.

The promotion runs from August 8, 2008 through March 13, 2010.
