RECOMMENDATION FOR THE AWARD OF THE NATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF MERIT WITH GOLD BADGE

1. PREAMBLE

- a. The award of the National Certificate of Merit with Gold Badge is the highest award that may be made by the League to a person who is not a member of any class of membership (save and except Affiliate Members or a member of a Women's Auxiliary).
- b. Nominees who are eligible to be RSL members are not eligible for this award.
- c. Recommendations are to be put forward by State Branches only. They must be approved by the National Executive before being awarded at State|Sub-Branch level.
- d. The success of an application not only depends on the information contained in the application form, but the quality and quantity of citations and references attached to the application form.
- e. Completed application forms, together with supporting citations and letters of recommendation, are to be forwarded to the CEO, Victorian Branch, RSL, ANZAC House, 4 Collins Street, Melbourne 3000, in an envelope marked 'Confidential'.
