- Put in charge at church in Ephesus (1 Tim 1:3)

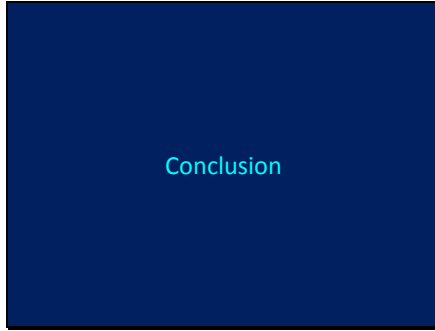

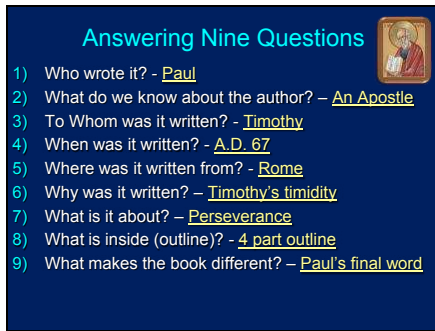

2 Tim 1:1- Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus <sup>[a]</sup>by the will of God, according to the promise of life in Christ Jesus

2

1 Cor. 15:8-9- and last of all, as <sup>[d]</sup>to one untimely born, He appeared to me also. <sup>9</sup> For I am the least of the apostles, <sup>[e]</sup>and not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

2 Tim 1:2- To Timothy, my beloved <sup>[b]</sup>son: Grace, mercy *and* peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

2 Tim. 4:6- For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come.

2 Tim 1:8- Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord or of me **His prisoner**, but join with *me* in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God.

1 Tim. 4:12- Let no one look down on your youthfulness, but *rather* in speech, conduct, love, faith *and* purity, show yourself an example <sup>[e]</sup>of those who believe.

1 Tim. 5:23- No longer drink water *exclusively*, but use a little wine for the sake of your stomach and your frequent ailments.



2 Tim. 1:7- For God has not given us a spirit of <sup>[f]</sup>timidity, but of power and love and <sup>[g]</sup>discipline.

2 Tim 1:8- Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord or of me **His prisoner**, but join with *me* in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God.

2 Tim. 2:18-*men* who have gone astray from the truth saying that the resurrection has already taken place, and they upset the faith of some.

2 Tim. 3:1-2-But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come. <sup>2</sup> For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy

2 Tim. 3:12-13-Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted. <sup>13</sup> But evil men and impostors will proceed *from bad* to worse, deceiving and being deceived.

2 Tim. 4:3-4-For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but *wanting* to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, <sup>4</sup> and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths.

2 Tim. 4:6-For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come.
