

## RELEASE OF INFORMATION FORM

In order to write letters of recommendation for students, faculty need to be able to integrate information concerning academic performance in general, performance in particular classes, aptitude for psychology or other fields, overall grade point average, and other factors that may be relevant to your potential for employment, graduate school, or other positions. However, Federal Educational Right to Privacy Act (FERPA) regulations limit the information about a student's record that faculty members may release to other parties without the consent of the student. In order to allow faculty to discuss all relevant factors, we ask that you read the following items and indicate which you will allow faculty to comment on in their letters of recommendation.
