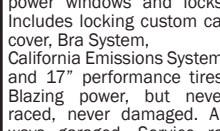

Notice is hereby given that Parker Ag Services, LLC has submitted an application to the Department of Ecology to obtain coverage under the General Permit for Biosolids Management.

The Washington Department of Ecology has reviewed documentation previously submitted in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) and has determined that for the purposes of this proposal, SEPA requirements have been satisfied.

Parker Ag Services, LLC applies biosolids as a soil amendment. Land application sites are located north and south of State Highway 2 near Farmer, WA. Current facilities received by Parker Ag Services: Cities of Arlington, Duvall, Buckley, Enumclaw, and Puyallup; Midway Sewer District (Kent), Southwest Suburban Sewer District (Burien), and Ace Acme Septic Service. Our permit application includes Site Specific Land Application Plans that address the management of our biosolids at these sites. Our permit application includes a General Land Application Plan that addresses how future land application sites will be identified and managed. Proposals for new sites will be consistent with our General Land Application Plan, and additional environmental review will be completed if needed. TAKE NOTICE: That on October 29, 2010 the United States Bureau of Reclamation (USBR) applied to transfer the above-referenced water right into the state's Trust Water Rights Program (TWRP) under amended trust water right application CS3-30556P. Said trust application covers release of water from Lake Roosevelt in 2010 totaling 305 cfs and 37,500 acre-feet.

Permit S3-30556P authorizes the release of 305 cfs and 37,500 acre-feet of water from Lake Roosevelt on the Columbia River, from a point of diversion located within Section 1, T. 28 N., R. 30 E.W.M., Grant County. Of the 37,500 acre-feet, 12,500 acre-feet will be for instream purposes in Lake Roosevelt and below Grand Coulee Dam along the mainstem Columbia River to the Pacific Ocean, and 25,000 acre-feet will be replacement water to enable new state water rights to be issued for future out-of-stream municipal and industrial uses. Trust water application CS3-30556P proposes to transfer these same quantities to the state TWRP.
