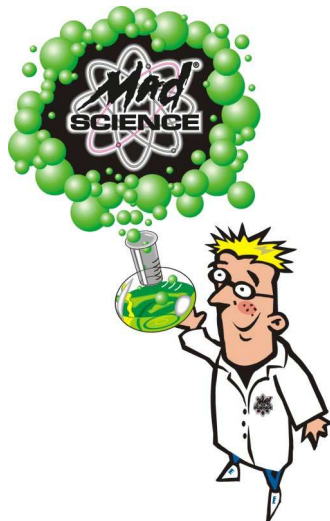

Look out 007- the Mad Science Secret Agent Lab is in session! From decoding messages to experimenting with metal detectors and night vision, children will have the opportunity to check out spy equipment and step into the shoes of a detective! Children will uncover the science involved in gathering and analyzing evidence and the technology behind locks, surveillance systems and alarms. To test the limits of magnified observation, junior science sleuths will build their own binoculars and develop ways to work together to refine their observation skills. Campers will use what they have learned as they find, collect, and analyze evidence and connect the dots to solve a simulated crime scene!



MAD MACHINES & ROCKIN ROCKETS!

Available: July 25 - 29 (week 6)

Mini Mad Scientists will delve into a multitude of scientific subjects as they learn about the Earth and its animal inhabitants, simple machines, rocketry and flight, and chemical reactions; there's something for everyone! Children will investigate the layers of the Earth and explore how various forces combine to create rocks and minerals. They'll also build and race a car to learn about physics and construct a rocket to investigate the wonders of flight and aerodynamics and take both projects home to continue the fun! Campers will also create animal tracks out of Plaster of Paris and have creepy-crawly fun building a bug-house used to search for new tenants! The Mad Scientist will astound the children as they witness remarkable color changes, experiment with acids and bases, and grow their very own crystal gardens to take home!

A day in the life of a Riegel Ridge Summer Camper...

All campers will have three activity periods each morning. These consist of crafts, nature & team-building activities, a variety of outdoor sports & games, and recreational swimming. The morning session will conclude with a picnic style lunch and half-day campers will be dismissed at 1:30pm. The afternoon continues in a similar fashion for full day campers who will be allowed free choice between outdoor sports games, crafts, as well as more recreational swimming. Pick up is scheduled for 4:30pm.

Extended Care Hours

Before Care - \$20 per week per camper. Our doors will open early for those that need to be dropped off prior to 8:30am. Before camp care will be available from **7:00am to 8:30am.**
After Care - \$20 per week per camper. We will also provide after care from **4:30pm to 6:00pm.**

SWIM LESSONS



Swim lessons are held in the morning during Summer Camp. Our water safety instructors will offer your child the opportunity to learn to swim in a safe and comfortable environment. Swim lessons are offered in two week blocks, be sure to sign your camper up for both weeks of Summer Camp. Class spaces are limited and extra fees will apply. Please take note of the price and week availability.

Lessons will be taught at the Riegel Ridge Community Pool. These lessons will be fun without pressure while students are surrounded by fellow campers. Classes will be divided by ability. All swim teachers are certified in the Red Cross Water Safety Instructor program. The WSI program teaches lessons for all swim levels. Students will learn appropriate safety and stroke skills that pertain to their specific level. We feel that level numbers are not an indication of a child's success in swimming. These numbers cater to a child's needs by placing focus on the appropriate skill set for their age and ability. The benefits of swim lessons for children are endless; but most importantly they provide your child the knowledge of how to handle a water emergency. Evaluations will be held prior to the start of the session to determine skill level. Sessions are run in 2 week periods. Your child must be signed up for the two weeks of camp to participate in swimming lessons. Lessons will be held 4 days per week (Monday-Thursday), refunds will not be given for cancelled lessons due to weather. Lessons are still held during light rain but are cancelled for heavy rain and thunder and lightening.

***If your camper misses a swim lesson due to going on a field trip, there will not be a make up lesson or a credit issued.**

ONLY available to full day camp families that sign up for at least 8 weeks of camp during the months of March, April or May.

A \$50 deposit per week is required, per camper and all afternoon adventures & field trips must be paid in **FULL** at time of registering camper(s). The total remaining cost will be divided into three equal payments: June 15, July 15 & August 15. Payments must be made with a credit card.

If you sign up for the payment plan & your card is declined, there will be a \$20 fee.
