To be considered for an ESL scholarship, you must:

- Currently be enrolled as a full-time ESL/TOEFL student for at least 12 weeks
- Have excellent attendance, above 90%, for past 12 weeks
- Not have received more than 2 scholarships per year
- Complete the application form
- Include a recommendation letter from your instructor
- Attach a statement explaining why you feel you deserve the scholarship

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic achievement, academic improvement, and financial need. In addition, community involvement and volunteer work are especially desirable. Students who do not receive a scholarship can reapply. Students that receive a scholarship will be credited 4 weeks. Recipients are obliged to contribute to the ESL Program's Newsletter.

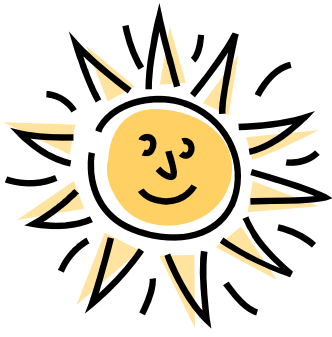

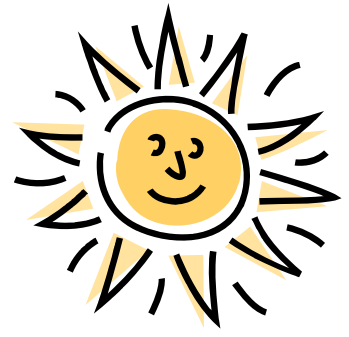
