

**R66 ADDENDUM TO HELICOPTER PURCHASE AGREEMENT:
PILOT REQUIREMENTS AND INDEMNITY**

This separate agreement between the manufacturer, Robinson Helicopter Company ("RHC"), and the Buyer is hereby incorporated into and made a part of the helicopter purchase agreement, or a separate agreement between RHC and Buyer if the helicopter is acquired through Resale. This Addendum applies to Robinson R66 helicopter serial number _____, registration number _____ ("the Subject Helicopter").

1. CONSIDERATION

Buyer and RHC agree that this Addendum has been the subject of discussion and negotiation and is fully understood by the parties and that the price of the Helicopter and the other mutual agreements of the parties were arrived at in consideration of the terms of this Addendum, specifically including RHC's commitment to provide a Factory Safety Course and the agreements and waivers by Buyer, as a commercial entity or sole proprietor, set forth in Paragraph 3 below.

2. PILOT AND USE REQUIREMENTS

Buyer agrees that only pilots who meet the requirements (A) through (D) below will be allowed to operate the Subject Helicopter as Pilot-In-Command (PIC):

- A. Flight instructors giving flight instruction in the Subject Helicopter must have completed the RHC Pilot Factory Safety Course during the preceding six years and have logged at least 500 hours in helicopters, including at least 50 PIC hours in an R44 or R66 helicopter.
- B. No pilot shall carry passengers in the Subject Helicopter until the pilot has completed the RHC Pilot Factory Safety Course and has logged at least 200 hours in helicopters, including at least 20 PIC hours in an R44 or R66 helicopter.
- C. The PIC must have completed an R66 familiarization and pilot check-out course conducted or approved by RHC.
- D. No passengers shall be carried in the rear seats of the Subject Helicopter during dual instruction, and the left seat controls must always be removed except when that seat is occupied by a rated helicopter pilot.

3. INDEMNIFICATION

Buyer agrees to ensure that adequate safeguards are in place to prevent any person from operating the Subject Helicopter other than in accordance with each of the requirements of Paragraph 2 above.

- A. Buyer further agrees that if for any reason the Subject Helicopter is not operated in accordance with each of the requirements of Paragraph 2. above, and as a non-exclusive remedy for such breach, Buyer will release, hold harmless, defend and indemnify RHC, its shareholders, officers, directors, employees, and suppliers for any and all liability including personal injury, death and/or property damage claims, cross-claims, liens and incidental or consequential damages arising from an accident involving the Subject Helicopter specifically including but not limited to any claim or remedy in contract or tort based on legal theories of negligence or strict products liability alleged or asserted against RHC.
- B. The agreements and waivers by Buyer set forth in this Paragraph shall be binding upon the Buyer's successors, assigns and/or heirs, and will expire 12 years after the time of shipment or departure of the Subject Helicopter from the RHC facility.

4. RESALE CONDITIONS

In the event of resale of the Subject Helicopter, Buyer agrees to obtain the new purchaser's prior written agreement to all the terms of this agreement, and to forward an original copy of such written agreement to RHC. In the event Buyer does not obtain such an agreement from the new purchaser, Buyer shall remain liable under Paragraph 3 above.

5. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be construed and performance thereof shall be determined according to the laws of the State of California, U.S.A.
