Description: This course uses lecture format in combination with classroom exercises to teach participants the basic principles of greenhouse gas accounting and inventory management. After completion of this two day course participants will understand how to construct, quantify and manage a greenhouse gas inventory.

Intended Audience: The course is designed around the basic principles of greenhouse gas accounting and inventory management. The course is suitable for individuals beginning this process. Participants should have some familiarity with MS Excel.

About the Instructor: Gail Sandlin is an environmental specialist for the Air Quality Program of Washington State's Department of Ecology. She specializes in greenhouse gas emissions and inventory management. Gail is a Doctoral Candidate at the University of Washington's Interdisciplinary Program in Urban Planning. As a recipient of U.S. EPA's prestigious STAR fellowship for doctoral studies, Gail's research area is the nexus of land use, transportation and air quality. For the last four years Gail has taught courses in environmental policy, planning and politics for Western Washington University's Huxley Environmental Studies program. Prior to her academic and government career, Gail had an extensive career in industrial environmental management.




