### **Catechetical Program ...and more**

#### Registration for 2010-2011 Year

Registration materials for the 2010 - 2011 year were sent home with all students in grades 1 - 7. Check the red folder for the paperwork! **Please return the Registration Form and pay the Program Fee no later than June 25, 2010**. If the paperwork did not make it home you can find it posted on our website.

Payment of the Program Fee, which will be **\$60 per child**, **must be made at the time of registration**. To ease the expense for families with multiple children we will only charge the fee for the first two children per family meaning the **maximum fee per family will be \$120**. We have not increased the fee for the past few years and unfortunately we cannot afford to continue serving our kids without an increase. This fee is necessary to cover the cost of the books and materials used during the year as well as other costs associated with the program such as the services of the police. As always, **if payment of this fee would be a hardship**, **please contact me**.

#### **Operation Rice Bowl**

You will recall that the students in our Monday and Thursday classes plus the students attending our school participated in Operation Rice Bowl during Lent. Rice bowls continued to be returned well past the conclusion of Lent. We think they have all been returned. The students understood and responded to the tremendous need of the many families who have no means to buy food. They raised **§2,569!** Many grateful families are being helped due to their generosity.

#### Looking for Volunteers Part 5

Maybe you have been reading recent articles asking people to consider serving in our Catechetical program and you would like to volunteer but you are afraid you won't be "good enough." Or you won't be able to "give enough" for the kids. "Good enough" and "giving enough" can mean any number of things. We know the kids deserve the best but we recognize our limitations. I'll list just a few of the ancillary comments I have heard. Maybe we are afraid we won't be able to spend enough time preparing. Maybe we are afraid the kids might ask a question and we won't know the answer. Maybe we have questions of our own about the Catholic Faith. Maybe... you fill in the rest.

All of us have limitations. It comes with being human. So I won't ask you if you are "good enough." What I will ask is if you are *generous enough*? Are you *open enough* to allow God to use you? As catechists we are called to echo God's word. Sure, we are the ones standing in the classroom. But whose work are we doing anyway? We are instruments.

Registrations are steadily coming in. We serve lots of kids. That means we need lots of Catechists. Ideally we have no more than 15 kids per catechist. Do the math... we generally have about 650 in our program
