Conditions of Entry

You need to ensure the following:

1. Garment is of sound construction, it has to stand up to being worn at least five times.
2. Hats or head pieces are well fitted and well balanced, a chin strap may be needed and please ensure the model can see to negotiate the catwalk.
3. Electrical wiring is safe and simple to operate.
4. Garment is safe to wear with no sharp objects.
5. Garment is to be an original for this show and not previously exhibited.
6. Garment is not excessively heavy.
7. Staples, tape or hot glue must not be totally relied on to hold materials together, other fasteners must be used effectively.
8. Your garment is a total concept e.g. if entering a skirt, there must also be an accompanying top.
9. There is a fabric label on the inside of your garment, which includes your name, phone no. and title of your garment. (Wearable Designz cannot take responsibility for unlabelled items)
10. There is no use of advertising signage or company logos in your design.

11. No perishable items are to be used.
12. Ensure your garment can safely negotiate 45 degree ramps to enter and exit the stage.
13. No garment to be wider than one and a half metres on the floor.
14. No garment to exceed three metres in height and must be able to enter and exit through standard double doors.
15. No garment to exceed three metres in length.
16. The model must exhibit the garment for all three shows and attend the scheduled dress rehearsals.
