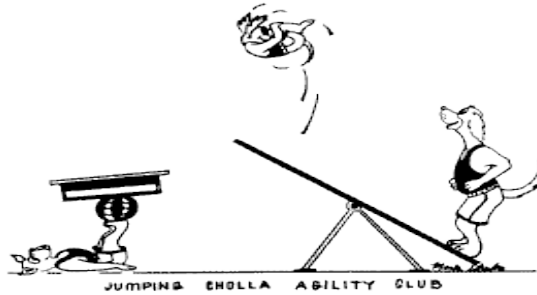

Beginners 1 Test - \$5.00 per run before day of show, \$6.00 day of show (No cost for the foundation class test night)

TENTATIVE RUNNING ORDER

Walk through and briefing will begin at **7:00 PM**, **First Testing** will begin at **6:15 PM** . There will only be one walk through per class.

Schedule subject to change as necessary.

Both runs alphabetical by dog name

- Running order is determined alphabetically.
- All Exhibitors for a given class should be present at ringside at least one-half hour prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing.
- Any dog and handler not present when called will be ineligible to run.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Exhibitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

- Dogs must have valid NADAC registration numbers before entries will be accepted. The application for a NADAC registration number is available at www.nadac.com.
- Please double-check your entry form to ensure it is filled out completely and correctly. Entry may be returned if missing information is critical to entry. Example, if the jump height is not listed or no NADAC #.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring.
- No Alcoholic Beverages allowed on the show site.
- Ribbons/Coupons will be awarded to those dogs that pass the test.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made
- Rubberized surfaces are used on the A-Frame

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC with Jumping Chollas Agility Club as the sponsoring club. NADAC rules will prevail. Exhibitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations and agree to abide by all the rules in effect at the time of this trial. The trial committee has the right to refuse entry to anyone including anyone not in good standing with NADAC

DOGS MUST BE REGISTERED AND HAVE A VALID REGISTRATION NUMBER BEFORE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels and divisions and equipment descriptions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook.

Purpose of Beginners Agility Tests

The purpose of a NADAC Beginners Agility Test is to demonstrate the ability of the dog and its handler to perform many of the basic tests to prepare them for a future agility career. The dog should be under control at all times and show a willingness to work with the handler. Handlers should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.

Eligibility for Entry

All healthy, trained dogs over twelve (12) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC Beginners Agility test. There is no leeway in the dog's age, even by one day; the dog **MUST** be a minimum of twelve months old on the day of the test in which the dog is to compete.

Dogs must be registered with NADAC prior to competing in a NADAC Beginners Agility test.

Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity that may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.

Any dog that demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the Beginners Agility test.

Any dog that the tester feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the test.

All NADAC Beginners Agility tests shall be open to purebred and mixed breed dogs.

Rules

All exercises are timed. The beginning of the time allowed will be indicated by the tester saying "good luck". The handler may have food and/or non-audible toys on them during the tests, although they may not be used during the tests.

Handlers may have up to 15 seconds between exercises to settle their dogs or praise them. The dogs should still remain under control of the handler and not run away or wander away sniffing between exercises.

The tester may end the test and not allow for any additional exercises to be performed if they feel that the dog is not under sufficient control of the handler.

All Beginners Agility tests shall start with test #1. The tests numbered #2-#5 can be in any order, as set by the designated tester. The BA test must end with tests #6 and #7, in that order.

Titles

Once a dog has three qualifying rounds in a Beginners Agility, they will receive their title for that level. If two testers are available, then a club may allow for two test rounds per dog on the same day. If more than one test is being allowed on the same day, then each round must have a different tester. Each tester shall approve the course setup and may change the order of tests #2-#5.

If only one round is allowed per BA test, then the club can use the same tester at each test on subsequent days.

No more than two tests in a 48 hour period. So a club may have one test per day for two days, or they could have two tests in one day.

Jump Heights

Dogs entered in the Proficient Category must jump at the minimum jump height specified by the following table. Dogs entering the Skilled Category **MUST** jump one jump height lower than the heights listed in the table, although no dog shall jump lower than 4".

All dogs must jump their valid jump height as determined by their Category and Division and may not jump higher.

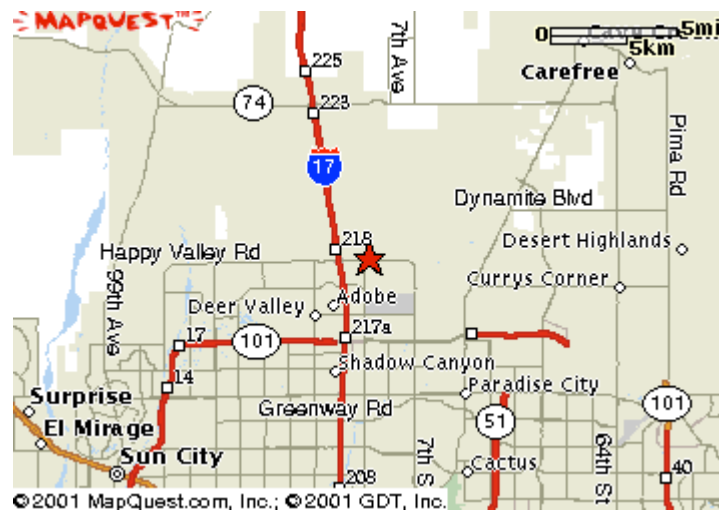

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
