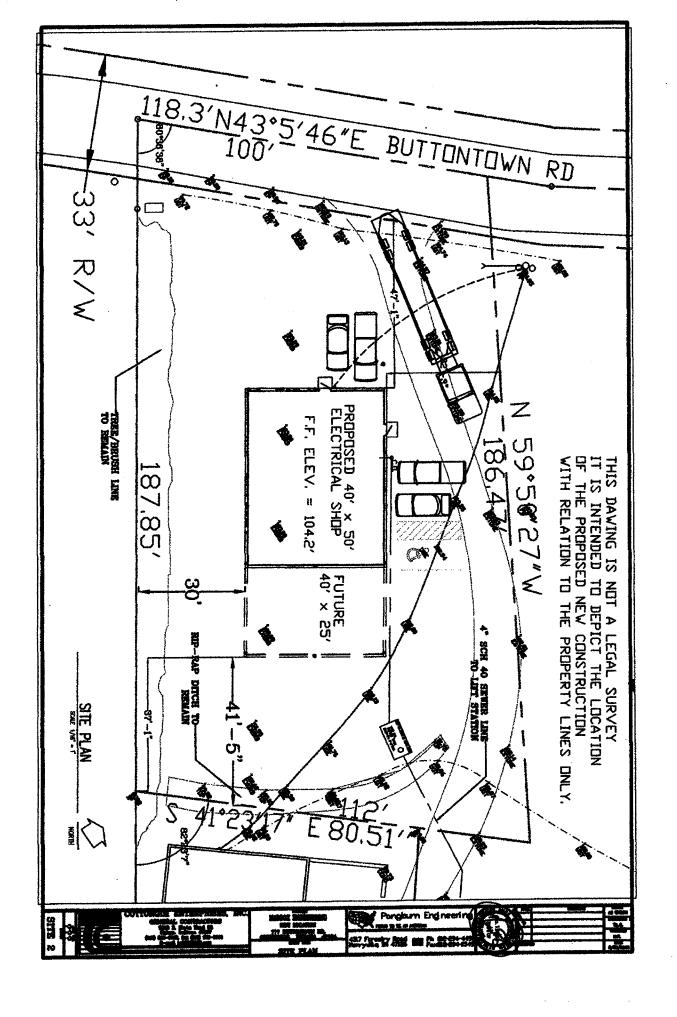



### ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF HOLIDAY BONUS PAY FOR THE GREENVILLE WATER UTILITY EMPLOYEES 2012

- 2. All future Holiday Bonus Ordinances shall be submitted for a vote by the Greenville Water Utility Council no later than the November Monthly Meeting each year.
- 3. Upon approval of this Ordinance the Holiday Bonus Pay shall be issued by a separate check with a notation made that it is Holiday Bonus Pay. This check shall be issued to Water Utility Employees the first pay period in December of 2012.
- 4. The following guideline shall establish the amount of compensation for years of employment;
  - ➤ Under One year employment = no compensation
  - ➤ One to Five years of employment = Five Hundred {\$500.00} U.S. Dollars
  - ➤ Six to Ten years of employment = One Thousand {\$1,000.00} U.S. Dollars
  - ➤ Eleven to Fifteen years of employment = One Thousand Five Hundred {\$1,500.00} U.S. Dollars
  - ➤ Sixteen to Twenty years of employment = Two Thousand {\$2,000.00} U.S. Dollars
  - > Twenty One to Twenty Five years of employment = Two Thousand Five Hundred {\$2,500.00} U.S. Dollars
  - > Twenty Six years and up of employment = Three Thousand {\$3,000.00} U.S. Dollars
- 5. This Ordinance does not apply to any Elected Official, Marshal Department Member, Town of Greenville Employee, OR Town Manager.
