- Enrollment is open to children ages (3-9) for the appropriate PK3-4th grade-level-designation by September 30th.
- The enrolled student must be toilet trained prior to enrollment.
- Students are accepted irrespective of race, gender or religious affiliation.
- To be eligible for enrollment, parent must present the following at the time of registration:
 - *Original Birth Certificate
 - *Social Security Card
 - Record of current Physical Examination completed by a physician
 - Proof of Address
 - Up-to-date Immunization Records (*See Below for Additional Medical Information)
 - Picture ID (for pick-ups)

***Submission of a current-year Commonwealth of VA School Entrance Health Form is mandatory:**

- Each page must be completed in its entirety accompanied with physician's signature and corresponding date.
- **Immunization record and annual physical examination must be included for: PK3, PK4, K5 and ALL FIRST TIME STUDENTS TO READY ACADEMY.**
- READY Academy reserves the right to request additional information at any time and can postpone enrollment/attendance until all information deemed necessary has been submitted, accordingly.
- If a condition and/or section does not pertain to the student child, **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE SECTION BLANK**. These sections can be marked "N/A" indicating Not Applicable. This confirms to staff that the student is not impacted by the information requested as well as the parent/guardian has reviewed the information in question.
- **READY Academy requires additional documentation/forms authorized by the student's physician for ALL prescriptions being requested to be administered during the period the student is at school.**

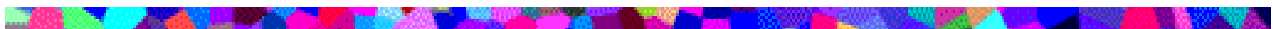
