

*Difference in fees based upon factors such as level of horses needed for particular Troop, barn needs for higher level horses, qualifications of Instructor, number of staff involved in helping, etc... Level 1 will automatically include a grooming, tacking, safety and handling session as part of the Troop curriculum. Parents are welcomed to discuss with the Instructors the performance of their children and their eligibility to move up to a higher level.

THE TROOP PROGRAM is geared to provide aspiring equestrians, interested in acquiring or improving their horsemanship and horseback riding skills, a forum to get involved in a *structured program* in a supportive and efficient environment.

Important: Please read before signing-up!

- LETTERS within numeric Levels do NOT indicate a choice of sessions but a progression
- ALL LEVELS require a *separate private* ¹/₂ *hour lungeing Safety Session* before upgrading to the next Level. This is because important safety issues such as safe transitions and stirrups recovery cannot efficiently be taught in a group situation. This small investment is important to your child's safety!
- IT IS NORMAL for most students to remain at a specific level for more than one semester
- **REFUNDS:** After the second session of the program, fees are not refundable, for any reason. In case of a refund after registration has occurred, a \$25 administrative fee will apply.
- TRANSFERS or CREDITS: No refunds, transfers or credits will be given for the two first missed sessions of Troop. Should a participant miss more than 2 sessions, the additional missed sessions will be credited towards other activities offered by the Barn and a \$25 administrative fee will apply.

Riders must be at least 8yr old but we will occasionally make exceptions on an individual basis and after an evaluation lesson. Level descriptions are available in the office for your perusal. A personalized assessment of your child's progress will be available either verbally or in writing at the end of Troop. A Friday Night SHS Mini Schooling Show may be made part of Troop. We reserve the right to consolidate or cancel levels. Instructor's recommendation, appropriate Badges, riding tests for the upper levels and, in some cases, remedial private lessons will be needed to upgrade Levels. In case of inclement weather riders go through a Horsemanship Badge of the instructor's choice.
