Nursery places for September 2016

We have now issued 'Nursery Application Packs' for parents to apply for a Nursery place from September 2016. Children must be aged 3 by the 31st August, 2016 to qualify. If you have a child, or know of anyone that may be interested in applying, please ask them to call into the

school office to collect a pack. The deadline date to apply is **March 11^{th,} 2016**.

We have a 52 place nursery catering for 26 children in the morning and 26 children in the afternoon. The sessions offer your child a three hour entitlement. The times for mornings are 8.45 - 11.45am and afternoon times are 12.15 - 3.15pm.
