#### Applicants/Recipients must:

- \* be at least a sophomore at an accredited college or university;
- \* be able to demonstrate interest in pursuing a career in newspapers;
- \* reside (or their parents must reside) in the communities served by the JournalNews.
- \* have a minimum 3.0 GPA for at least the previous academic year;
- \* have scholarship application and supportive materials submitted to either newspaper by **June 4, 2007**

#### Supportive materials to include:

- \* College transcripts
- \* One letter of recommendation
- \* Essay (defined in application)
