We will be camping in Akela Lodge The entrance to the lodge is on Leffingwell Rd about 1000 ft west of the camp entrance. There's room for tents to be set up for those interested in doing so.

Bring: Money for lunch on Saturday, admission fee for the National Packard Museum is covered by the campout fee.

We will depart from the St. Basil parking lot on Friday, March, 22nd at 6:00 pm. We will return to St. Basils by 11:00 am on Sunday. Most will drive themselves or arrange carpools

Take Turnpike East toward Youngstown. I-80 East (45 miles) to Exit 224 for OH 11 South toward Canfield. Take exit 34 for US-224 toward Us-62/Poland/Canfield and go left. After 1/3 mile, turn right on Co. Rd. 109/S. Raccoon Rd. Left on Co. Rd. 74/Leffingwell Rd. Go about a mile to Camp Stambaugh entrance but continue past the entrance about 1000 ft to the Akela Lodge entrance on the north side of the road. You can avoid the turnpike with 77 South to I-76 East.

On Saturday, about 12:00 noon we will tour the Packard Museum. Admission cost is included in the camp fee paid to the troop. The visit should last less than 2 hours. Then we will find a fast food restaurant in town before returning to camp. Everyone is expected to pay for their own lunch.
