FROM THE OFFICE

Hello Fellow Cutters,

Time has marched on and all the clubs are busy planning training days and shows, remember to keep an eye on the NZCHA website www.nzchacutting.com, for the very latest updates and information that may not appear in current Chatters. It is also a timely reminder if you have not paid your NZCHA membership by the 31st October 2013, this will be your last chatter and you cease to be a financial member of the NZCHA.

SHOW CONDUCT REMINDER

“Misconduct” – includes any conduct considered to be unworthy of a sportsman or calculated to induce a breach of the peace or to create a nuisance or to prejudice the smooth running or prestige of any recognised competition.
“Zero Tolerance Policy” – Please read page 27 of the Rule book, this refers to everyone at all times whilst at a NZCHA approved event, regardless weather in the show pen or any other location that is associated with the NZCHA.

“Dress Code” – Any person in the arena after the start of an NZCHA approved event must wear western attire, including hats. Men must wear long sleeved shirts with collar and buttons or snaps completely down the front. T-shirts and slip over knits are not permissible. Women must wear long sleeved shirts with a collar, sweater may be worn over an appropriate shirt. Sleeves must be rolled down. In extreme weather, show management with the consent of the judge may allow deviation from dress requirements with regard to hats and or sleeve length (in NZ Jackets may also be worn with the Judges consent).

“Training Equipment” – All horses must comply with Rule 16 (page 94) while in the arena.

“Help Horses” – Their condition and fitness must be equal to the amount of work they will be asked to perform. Close attention must be paid to the duration of time in which a help horse is used. Their feet must be properly trimmed or shod. Owners who supply help horses expect their horses to be treated with respect by anyone who uses them, these horses work longer and harder than the “Cutting Horse”, be nice to them.

“Communication with the Judge” – A contestant shall not talk with the judge(s) beyond the exchange of normal greetings during the show, nor shall a contestant discuss with the judge any previous scores, events, or related happenings within thirty (30) days after a contest in which both parties participated.

“Loping Pen Rules”

1. Horses not entered in the current cutting class are prohibited from the loping pen or area where horses enter into the competition ring. (This does not apply to help horses).
2. No horse can carry two or more persons at any time in the loping pen or competition arena.
3. Horses cannot be lead from another horse in the loping area.
4. When entering the loping pen yield to all horses in motion.
5. Enter the stream of horse traffic from the outside in the same direction as the group and look around before leaving the group to avoid contact with another horse.
6. Stay to the inside of the group if you wish to go slow, stay to the outside if you wish to go fast.
7. Never stop in traffic. Dry work should be done in an area where there is no traffic.
8. Riders must be in control of their horse at all times.
9. Helmets must be worn by persons under the age of 18 if they are not a member of the NZCHA or competing at the show.
10. All lopers must follow the NZCHA attire rules while in the loping pen.
11. Do not weave in and out of traffic and avoid contact with other horses. Maintain constant speed in your position.
12. Change direction and maintain the flow in one direction when asked. Always ask when you wish to change direction.
13. Apply boots and groom in areas with no traffic.
14. If you must tie your horse, tie them to a secure fence, not panels. Do not tie stallions, kicking or biting horses in the loping pen in the traffic areas.
15. Yield to all vehicles, pedestrians or horses wishing to enter or exit the loping area.
16. Maintain NZCHA animal welfare rules while in the loping area.
17. Keep a good sense of humour and be courteous to everyone in the loping area.
18. Do not ride under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
19. Adjust stirrup lengths to suit person riding the horse.
20. All horses must be ridden in approved NZCHA equipment while in the loping area.

AFFILIATED CLUB – NZCHA INSURANCE

Please note that if an affiliated club advertises via the NZCHA Council and chatter a training day it will come under the NZCHA umbrella for Liability cover only for NZCHA financial members attending, non-members that create an issue will be the responsibility of the Club hosting the training. Any other training days where NZCHA members are involved will not be covered by the NZCHA Insurance.

SHOW APPROVALS

Show approvals must be received by the Islands Show Approvals Councillor as per standing rules prior to being submitted for inclusion in the Chatter or on the NZCHA website, in the case of a clash of dates, it will be first in gets the date, however the Council would like clubs to negotiate any conflicting dates between themselves, prior to submitting show applications. Island clubs are encouraged to discuss their Island finals and National Finals between clubs for hosting rights, submission to host the National finals will be required by NZCHA.

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NZCHA Futurity First Year Incentive Buckle

What is the Futurity First Year Incentive? *The Futurity First Year Incentive is a buckle presented to the rider-trainer competing in their first Futurity event, who receives the highest score.*

Who qualifies for the Futurity First Year Incentive Buckle? *A Rider-trainer who prepares and competes their first ever futurity prospect.*

How much does it cost to enter the First Year Incentive? *There is no extra entry fee attached to the advertised Open Futurity Entry Fee to enter the First Year Incentive, however the Pre-registration form must be completed and sent to the Futurity Secretary. The Pre-Registration fee is part of the total nomination fee required.*

How will the event be judged? *The First Year Incentive will be judged as standard in the Open Futurity Event. In the case of a tie between First Year Rider-trainers, regardless of where they place in the actually futurity, a run off for the buckle is required.*

What will the Winner receive? *The winner of the First Year Incentive will receive a trophy buckle, there is no extra purse for this incentive.*

 - An explanation of the new first year incentive is to be published in the Chatter. Action Karen. Consideration to include a new owner's incentive and a breeder incentive were also discussed, but not to be actioned for 2014.

NZCHA FUTURITY HISTORY

Part One

1981 1st NZCHA North Island Futurity.

Held on the 9th August 1981 at the Taupo Western Riding Arena.

Judges Bryan Lowcay and Bob Ramsay

This write up is taken from the Futurity Year Book

The North Island Cutting Horse Futurity held August 9th 1981, attracted ten horses from throughout the North Island. They were held in Taupo Western Riding Arena in cold and sometimes wet conditions.
